Sections of scattered heat in the interior continue to cool which is reflected in larger areas of isolated heat sources inside the perimeter. <br> -The fire has crossed Paradise Ridge to the south and is moving towards Squirrel Creek. <br> -The fire does not appear to have crossed Marble Fork, but I can't be $100 \%$ certain. If it has crossed it would be in Deep Canyon, north of Potwisha Campground, IVO the end of Potwisha Flume Access Road. <br> -The fire has arrived at and appears to have crossed the General's Highway IVO Hospital Rock picnic area and further north IVO Amphitheater Point |  |  |  |
