Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Growth acreage calculated using 85,952ac figure from 20211007 1914PDT update as the starting acreage. -Cloud/smoke obscuring imagery NW Perimeter IVO NF-14S75 and Old Sawmill Rd. -Cloud/smoke obscuring imagery SE Corner in direction of Silver City / Cabin Cove. -Cloud/smoke obscuring imagery for much of the SSW border and southern interior. Acreage is almost certainly underreported as I did not capture areas that were obstructed by clouds/smoke, but most likely were burned or burning at expanded points along the perimeter. Isolated and scattered heat may be underreported as well. Only positively identified heat locations were recorded on the map.
