Judging isolated vs scattered heat more of a toss-up. -Clouds were heavy over large areas which blocked all heat signatures in those areas. That is what is drawn on the map with the cloud tool. -Large-ish finger moving north from East Fork Kaweah River towards Mineral King Road at Atwell Mill Ranger Station and Campground.
