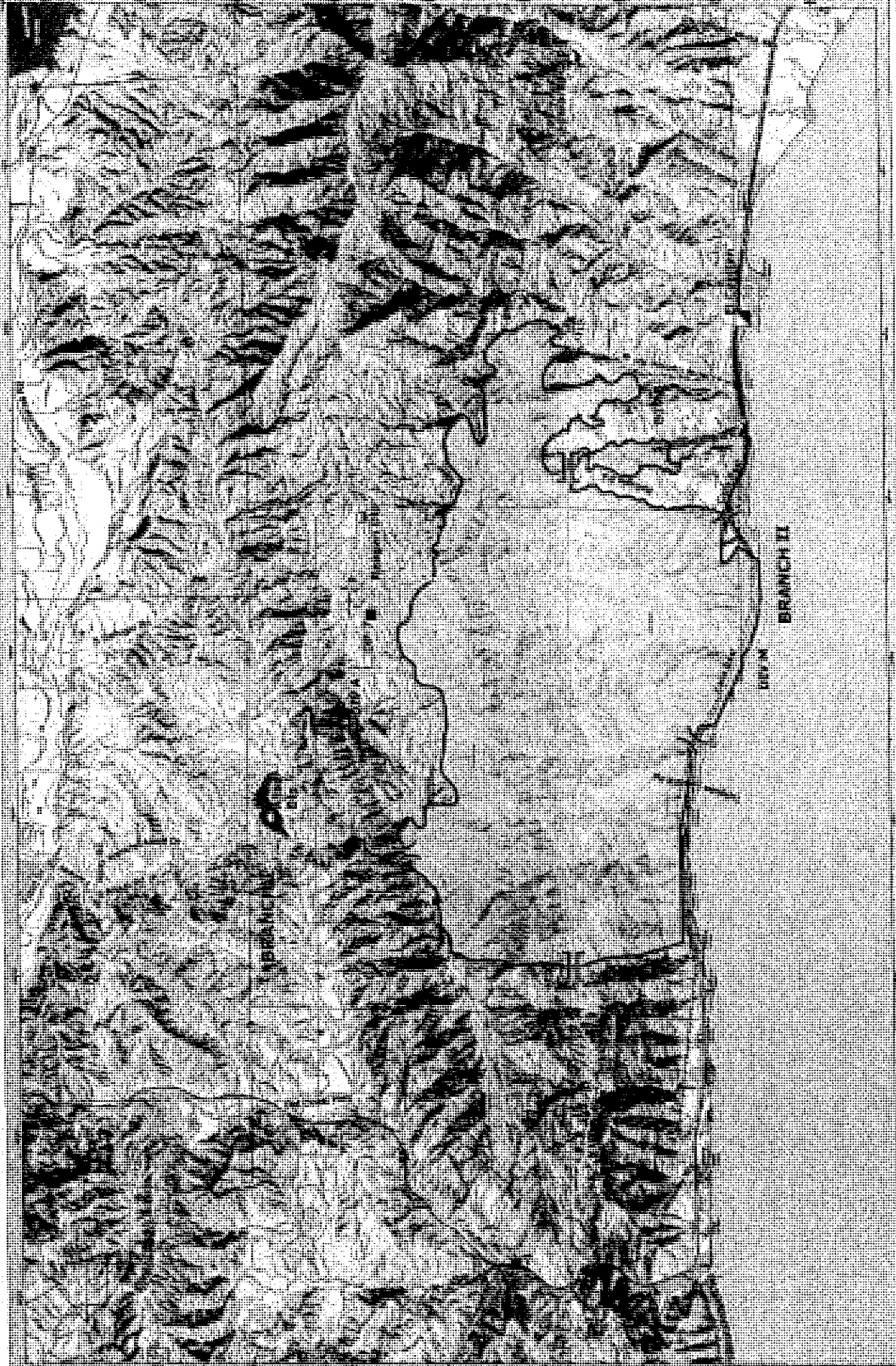
If you answered Yes to these symptoms, report it to your supervisor immediately, self-isolate away from other people until given direction and call **MEDICAL**.

1. An STL is sitting in a vehicle with a Division Supervisor for 10-15 minutes or greater without wearing a face covering...Document this!
2. Someone from another work group enters your work space without a face covering for 10-15 minutes of greater...Document this!
3. Personnel from Division Alpha ties in with Division Bravo without a face covering and no proper social distancing...Document this!
