WEATHER DISCUSSION: High Pressure will rebuild Today through Monday for a warming and drying trend and a return of northerly flow.

WEATHER FORECAST:

WEATHER: Mostly Clear except for Smoke and haze in the Sisquoc and Cuyama River Valleys in the morning and again tonight.

TEMPS: Max 83 ridges to 92 valleys
Min 60-65 mid and upper slopes...55 valleys and lower slopes.

HUMIDITY: Min 15-18%
Max 35-40%...except 45% below 4000 ft MSL

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - 0600-0900 PDT... Northeast 5-10 mph
1000-2000 PDT... Northwest 5 mph with gusts 10 mph
0000-0600 PDT...Northeast 10 mph with gusts 15 mph

SLOPE/VALLEY - till 0900 PDT.....Downslope/down valley 2-5 mph.
1000-1600 PDT...Upslope 5-10 mph with gusts 20 mph.
1700-2200 PDT...West to northwest 10 mph with gusts 25 mph
2300-0600 PDT...Downslope/Down valley 3-5 mph with gusts 10 mph.

MIXING HEIGHT: till 0900 PDT.....Inversion around 4000 ft
1000-2000 PDT...Mixing to 9000 ft MSL
after 2100 PDT....Inversion near 4200 ft.

TRANSPORT WIND: North 7 mph...becoming east 5 mph after 0200 PDT.

Forecast for Thursday: (*OPERATIONAL PERIOD – 0600 PDT 08/09/07 - 0600 PDT 08/10/07*)
Mostly clear. Highs 85 ridges to 97 valleys. Lows 65 to 70 except 55 in the valleys. Minimum Relative Humidity 11-16%. Maximum Relative Humidity 20 to 25% mid and upper slopes...30% in the valleys. Ridge level winds northeast 10 mph with gusts 20 mph except north to northwest 10 mph in the afternoons and evenings. Slope winds...upslope 5 to 8 mph with gusts 25 mph up valley; down slope 3 to 5 mph with gusts 15 mph down valley.

Outlook...August 10-13 2007

.Friday through Monday...Mostly clear and dry with a warming trend. Highs 85 to 92 upper slopes...95-100 mid and lower slopes...100 to 105 valleys. Lows 70 to 75 mid and upper slopes... 55 to 60 lower slopes and valleys. Ridge winds northeast 10 mph with gusts 20 mph...except northwest 10 to 15 mph afternoons and evenings.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure is starting to rebuild with the return of a northerly flow. Temperatures will start to warm up with humidity starting to drop.

SEE ATTACHED INCIDENT METEOROLOGIST WEATHER FORECAST.

PROBABILITY OF IGNITION = 66% on north aspects to 100% on south aspects.

Live Fuel Moistures are below critical at around 51% at Upper Oso.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: Expect the inversion to affect the type of fire and timing of fire activity through the shift. Areas above the inversion will burn actively early in the morning. As the inversion lifts around 0900-1100 expect a weak cap on the fire. However, the fire will burn actively when aligned with slope and winds due to low live fuel moistures. Fire behavior is expected to increase during the late afternoon and early evening as the inversion drops in elevation.

SPECIFIC

Division DD – The fire is well established in Upper Sisquoc especially in Rattlesnake and Big Pine Canyons. The fire is backing slowly down into the Sisquoc. The northerly winds should help keep movement into the Sisquoc in check; however, the fire will burn actively when in alignment with slope and wind making runs at the ridge just west of Big Pine. Expect group tree torching in pockets of timber with spotting distances of up to ½ mile possible during the burn period. Two spot fires exist on the top of an intermediate ridge in upper Sisquoc but very little movement is expected.

Division EE – Fire that slopped over the Buckhorn Road several days ago has moved very little down into Alamar Canyon. The northerly winds have the potential to push fire laterally to the south and further down into Alamar Canyon, if unchecked by water or retardant drops. Any lateral spread should moderate around 0900-1100 as the inversion begins to lift. Expect fire activity to increase as the inversion begins to drop in the late afternoon.

AIR OPERATIONS: The inversion will affect aircraft out of Rancho Helibase until around 1000. Visibility on the east and south sides of the fire could be impacted by smoke.

SAFETY

- All fuelbeds are carrying fire. Expected enhanced spotting potential today as the drying trend affects the flammability of the smaller size class fuels
- Prime time for burning is early morning and late afternoon or early evening.

Make sure instructions are clearly understood!!

Complacency - Challenge one another to stay alert, creative and safe. Be patient.

Fire Order of the Day –Give clear instructions and be sure they are understood

Narrative: The transition period between incident management teams can be one of the most confusing times on a fire. If there was going to be a Watch Out Situation #19 added, this would be a good candidate. Communicating with new people means we can't take anything for granted. Please take the time today to make sure instructions given and received are clearly understood. Don't assume anything and don't be afraid to ask questions. We can make this transition clean and seamless if everyone pays particular attention to communication today. Most of all, we can ensure that this transition is SAFE AND ACCIDENT FREE! Stay heads up and have a safe day.

Escape Route/Safety Zone Checklist

Escape Routes:

- *More than one escape route

- *Natural – clean burn, water, bare soil/rock
