### FIVE HAZARDOUS ATTITUDES (This applies to all of us, not just pilots!)

Flight out of Balance (two in a series of five)

### 2 Impulsivity

Some pilots feel the need to do something-anything-immediately when confronted with a choice of action. "I must act now - there's no time," they say to themselves. What makes this attitude hazardous is that these pilots usually do the first thing that enters their heads; in other words, they don't think. They don't take the time to select the best alternative.

Decisiveness is a positive attribute in a pilot, but making a decision in the absence of facts is a dangerous habit. "Plan your flight, then fly your plan," the military teaches its pilots. To fly safely, you must always have alternative courses of action in mind should something to wrong right *now*. (Sometimes this is mandated, as in alternate airport requirements under instrument flight rules.) Among other benefits, this reduces overall pilot workload.

Regardless of the swiftness of the onset of an unusual situation, it behooves the smart pilot to take a moment to analyze the situation, carefully consider the alternatives, and then make a decision based on the best possible course of action under the circumstances. It need not take more than a moment if the pilot has the right decision making attitude.

### **HAZARD MITIGATIONS**

**POISON OAK:** Poison Oak has become an issue with the crews coming off the line. The Los Padres has been known for their abundance and robust Poison Oak. Shower often when you can, see the laundry service often, and visit Medical Unit sooner than later for lotions and potions. Don't wait until the condition becomes severe to obtain help.

**CUMULATIVE FATIGUE:** A number of personnel are on their second or third tour of duty here on the Zaca. We need to continue to monitor their health and welfare. Keep hydrating and pace yourself by your distance. Adhere to the 2:1 work ratio. Fatigue can effect your decision making process.

**FIRE BEHAVIOR/WEATHER:** We are one again transitioning into a hotter and dryer weather pattern. These are the conditions which significantly contributed to the past large spread of this fire. Expect fire behavior to be very active and plan accordingly. Constantly observe weather and burning conditions and always have a contingency plan for any situation.

**INCIDENT TRANSPORTATION: Highway 154 is open.** Exercise care when entering and exiting highway. Remember the speed is 54 mph. Expect periods of heavy weekend traffic. Incident travel routes and travel distances can be long, and local residents continue to share the roads. Be alert for traffic, drive with your lights on, keep your speed down, and anticipate other drivers' actions. The camp speed limit is 5 mph.

A firefighter with good situational awareness is a safe firefighter.




