

FIVE HAZARDOUS ATTITUDES (This applies to all of us, not just pilots!)

Flight out of Balance (five in a series of five)

5 Resignation

The flip side of the invulnerability coin is the attitude of resignation. "What's the use?" say pilots who feel they have little control over what happens to them. They do not see themselves as players in their own lives' dramas. They feel that circumstances are governed by luck, and they leave action to others, allowing other people or commitments to influence their decisions. They are resigned to leaving things as they are, and they may deny that a situation is as critical as it appears.

But listen to William Ernest Henley "It matters not how strait the gate, How charged with punishments the scroll, I am the master of my fate: I am the Captain of my soul." Henley was not a resigned man. Above all, "the pilot in command of an aircraft is directly responsible for, and is the final authority as to, the operation of the aircraft" FAR 91.3(a). No controller, no instructor or set of rules or procedures can help you unless you are firmly and comfortably in command of your flight. It's your ship; you are the captain, and you are the master of your fate.

Antidote: When things look bleak, say to yourself "I'm not helpless. I can make a difference."

Become alert to hazardous attitudes creeping into your flight activities. Sensitizing yourself to them is the first important step in eliminating them

HYDRATION ISSUES: Hydrate often, these high temperatures (100+), low Relative Humidity's (<10%) and poor overnight recoveries mandate we drink plenty of fluids. Complete evaporation of 1 liter of sweat removes 580 kilocalories of heat. In order to maintain a healthy body temperature, the firefighter needs to evaporate about 1 liter (slightly more than 1 quart) of sweat during each hour of work. <u>Hydration issues are very preventable with attention to detail</u>:

- Maintaining body fluids is essential for sweating. You must hydrate before, during, and after work.
- Before work you should take extra fluids to prepare for the heat. Drink 1 or 2 cups of water, juice, or a sport drink before work. Avoid excess caffeine; it hastens fluid loss in the urine.
- While working drink at least 1 quart of fluid per hour. Drink as much as you can during the lunch break. Water is your greatest need during work in the heat.
- Providing a portion of fluid replacement with a carbohydrate/electrolyte sport beverage will help you retain fluids and maintain energy and electrolyte levels.
- You can assess your hydration by observing the volume, color, and concentration of your urine. Low volumes of dark, concentrated urine, or painful urination indicate a serious need for re-hydration. Other signs of dehydration include a rapid heart rate, weakness, excessive fatigue, and dizziness.
- Keep a close eye on each other for signs of dehydration.

CUMULATIVE FATIGUE & COMPLACENCY: Crews have been on fires all year, and this incident is 40+ days old. People are tired, both physically and mentally and this can lead to accidents if care is not taken. Maintain your situational awareness and don't let complacency creep into your work. Concentrate on doing the job safely. This includes wearing the proper full PPE, and taking the hot, dry weather into consideration.

FIRE BEHAVIOR/WEATHER: We are in a very hot and dry weather pattern. These are the conditions which significantly contributed to the past large spread of this fire and crew heat-related issues. Expect fire behavior to be very active and plan accordingly. Constantly observe weather and burning conditions and always have a contingency plan for any situation.
