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**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Slightly cooler during the operational period with slight increase in humidity. Typical slope/valley winds will continue with some gusty afternoon upslope winds. Ridgetop winds will shift to the southwest to west this morning and continue through the period. Sunday will see a little more cooling. However for Monday and Tuesday...warmer and drier conditions will develop.

## **FIRE BEHAVIOR FORECAST**

### **GENERAL FIRE BEHAVIOR:**

Once again the fire will remain fuels and topography driven. Upslope up canyon winds will determine the direction of fire spread during the day. Were RH is below 25% expect active burning with torching. Spot fires from roll outs will continue to challenge containment. Fire progression will be mainly by flanking fire with short intense upslope runs where slope and fuels align. Down canyon winds during the night will push the fire down canyon. Where wind, slope and fuels align expect rates of spread to 100cph. With flame lengths of 30-60ft. Retardant has been effective holding the fire at fuel transitions.

### **SPECIFIC:**

#### **Branch V**

- No forward fire progression expected. Watch for hold over heat on steep slopes.

#### **Branch VII**

- Expect the fire to continue down the Mono drainage.
- Main fire progression is to the east, expect short intense runs in continuous fuels.
- Active down canyon movement should be expected all night.

#### **Branch IX**

- Fire is established along Monte Arido, any slop overs that become established will run to the east. Expect rates of spread at 80-100cph during the peak burn period.
- Fire progression will be by spot fires from roll outs with intense uphill runs.
- The fire will continue to burn down canyon all night long.
- Fire is established in Diablo Canyon expect runs to the south and east.

**Air Operations:** Smoke from the fire will limit air operations until 1100-1200hrs.

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### **SAFETY:**

**Time tag your tactics to the fire behavior to allow adequate time to get to a safe area.**

**HELICOPTER TRANSPORTATION:** Caution must ALWAYS be used when working around or traveling in helicopters. Helicopter personnel will provide detailed briefings on helicopter safety procedures to all personnel prior to loading. Listen to these instructions carefully and make sure you understand them. Follow the instructions of helicopter personnel at all times when around helicopters.

**COYOTE-IN-PLACE STAFFING:** When crews are working a coyote-in-place work schedule, this presents some unique problems. Crews are sleeping under less than optimum conditions. Sanitary and hygiene conditions become an issue. Much effort is made to support crews on the line but they are still operating under challenging conditions. Take extra precautions to keep yourself healthy under these conditions. Follow the work-rest cycle guidelines: work a maximum of 16 hours and rest for 8.

**FIRING OPERATIONS:** During firing operations it is important to observe all basic safety precautions. All firing must be done by a qualified individual and carefully coordinated with adjoining crews and divisions. Pay particular attention to the LCES components of the 10 Standard Orders. Maintain your situational awareness at all times.

**NEAR MISSES:** Near misses or close calls should be shared with the entire crew at a crew briefing. We need to be especially careful; as there is a historical ratio between the number of near misses, accidents, and fatalities- we need to reduce the number of near misses we experience!

**Safety on this incident has been very good. This is due to your efforts to make it happen. Please keep it up.**
