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**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Little change during the operational period....continued hot and dry. Typical slope/valley winds will continue with some gusty afternoon upslope winds. Ridgetop winds southwest to west...but will become northerly this evening.

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**Weather Summary:** See weather forecast. Continued warm & dry.

Winds – day, SW 4-10, gusts 18.

RH – Min, 8-22%, Max, 25-65%

Temp – Max, 81-99, Min, 55-71

### **Fire Behavior**

#### **General:**

The fire will remain fuels and topography driven. Upslope up canyon winds will determine the direction of fire spread during the day. When RH is below 25% expect active burning with torching. Spot fires from roll outs will continue to challenge containment. Fire progression will be mainly by flanking fire with short intense upslope runs where slope and fuels align. Down canyon winds during the night will push the fire down canyon. Where wind, slope and fuels align expect rates of spread to 100 ch/hr. Flame lengths will reach 30-60ft. Retardant has been effective holding the fire at fuel transitions.

#### **Specific:**

**Div N,O,P,Q,R,S,T** – Patrol for flare-ups & spots. There are some interior islands of unburned fuels that do have some potential to create enough energy to spot. It is unlikely, but possible.

**Div M, TT** – Great job yesterday! Check for spots that may have occurred overnight due to rolling firebrands or downslope winds. New spots will burn rapidly towards your line. The black will make a good safety zone, but watch for convective heat!

**Div UU** – Great job here also! Watch for spots that may have occurred over night due to rolling firebrands or downslope winds. (See comments in Div M, TT). Winds should be favorable to finish burnout of division. Watch for wind to change to NE in evening.

**Div VV, ZZ** – Pay close attention to neighboring divisions. If they have problems it may also affect you. Winds will favor burning out firelines with an east to west orientation. Those portions of the lines with a more north to south orientation are likely to experience troublesome winds which will cast smoke, heat, and spots across containment lines, especially in areas of doglegs in the line. Be patient with the amount of heat generated during burnout.

**Air Operations:** Air operations will be hampered until about 1100 due to smoke.

**Safety:** Keep track of safety zones (black) and how difficult the escape routes are to them. It may be difficult to find spot fires in the morning due to the inversion.

## TRANSFER OF COMMAND

Risks to fireline personnel increase significantly during transfer of command periods regardless of the size or complexity of the incident. There is a high potential for fatalities, serious injuries, or incidents with potential during transfer of command periods (some have occurred in the past). Be proactive in mitigating the risks by proper implementation of LCES—Lookout, Communications, Escape Routes, and Safety Zones.

● Factors for increased risks to fireline personnel during transition periods include:

- No, or poor, briefing of incoming personnel
- Lack of fire weather and behavior information, both forecast and observed
- Communications; face-to-face briefings may not be possible and radio frequencies may be overextended and/or changing due to the increased demands on the system.
- Initial attack resources may not have checked-in and the Incident Commander may not be aware of the number, type and location of all resources.
- Location of safety zones and escape routes may not be known and communicated to all resources.

● Mitigation actions to take:

- Lookouts: Post and maintain your own lookouts.
- Communications: Maintain existing communications with your own and adjacent resources, as well as your original supervisor, while you are developing communications with incoming adjacent resources and your new supervisor.
- Escape routes and safety zones: Identify escape routes and assure incoming resources are aware of their locations; be aware that your original escape routes and safety zones may no longer be accessible due to changing fire behavior or your increased distance from them.
