<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION:</u> Slightly cooler but more humid conditions will prevail across the area during the operational period...due to the influence of remnant moisture from former Hurricane Dean. There will be a slight chance of showers or thunderstorms as the moisture continues to move across the area. Ridgetop winds will be southerly through most of the day...then turn to the west to northwest by the evening. Typical slope/valley winds will continue.

**ERC** – 66 at about 96 percentile setting a record for today again.

# **Fire Behavior**

### General:

Potential Fine Fuel Moisture unshaded is 3% and Probability of Ignition at 90% Potential Fine Fuel Moisture shaded is 6% and Probability of Ignition at 60%

Keep monitoring unburned fuels between the fire and the line, there are several pockets that continue to hold heat. Continue to monitor the Probability of Ignition on the north slopes where the fire & heat continues to show up. 60% Probability of Ignition indicates a high risk environment for rapid rates of spread and extreme fire behavior. Where wind, slope and fuels align expect rates of spread to be from **100 - 250 ch/hr**. Flame lengths could reach **25-40ft**. Daily upslope winds are dependant on solar heating and shading, therefore aspect becomes very important to monitor throughout the day. Competing upslope and general winds may cause erratic fire behavior.

# **Specific:**

**Div Q** – The fire in Santa Cruz drainage continues to smolder and creep around. With the predicted upslope winds, significant fire activity in this area is unlikely, but possible. **DIV TT** – The heat in the unburned fuels here has been mostly creeping and smoldering, but, needs to be monitored throughout the day. The predicted upslope winds may cause a short run

toward the line.

**Div VV** — Although the IR flight has picked up heat in this area, crews have worked extensively in this division to find the hot spots. No heat has been found in this area, but should be monitored throughout the day.

**Richardson Zone or initial attack -** Live fuel moistures continue to be at record lows throughout Southern California. This combined with the potential probability of ignition today could lead to extreme fire behavior. Winds will push the Richardson side of the fire either upslope or toward the northerly depending on where you are on the slope. Fuels on this side of the fire are slightly different than the Live Oak side, but are equally as dry and can burn equally as intense.

**<u>Air Operations</u>**: Air operations will be hampered by some gusty winds and will create turbulence and difficult flying conditions.

**Safety:** Maintain situational awareness at all times, no matter what your job is. You may be reassigned very quickly to a fast moving fire. Monitor the weather and probability of ignition throughout the day to keep your SA up.


