...FIRE WEATHER WATCH IN EFFECT FRIDAY NIGHT AND SATURDAY FOR LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY AND OFFSHORE WINDS...

WEAK ONSHORE FLOW WITH A SHALLOW MARINE LAYER WILL CONTINUE SIMILAR WEATHER THROUGH FRIDAY MORNING. OFFSHORE FLOW WILL DEVELOP FRIDAY NIGHT AND CONTINUE UNTIL SATURDAY AFTERNOON.
