

WEATHER DISCUSSION: High pressure will re-build over the region today. As a result... a slight warming and drying trend will happen (depending upon smoke coverage). In addition... some lingering monsoon moisture combined with daytime heating will develop afternoon cumulus, but no thunderstorms are anticipated. Overall wind flow will continue to be terrain driven with gusty afternoon southwest flow.

WEATHER FORECAST:

TODAY:

WEATHER: Mostly sunny with cumulus builds ups in the afternoon. Areas of smoke.

MAX TEMPERATURES: Lower elevations 93-103

24 HOUR CHANGE: warmer 1-2

Upper elevations 84-92

MIN HUMIDITY: lower elevations 13-23%...upper elevations 17-30%

24 HOUR CHANGE: little

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP – North to northeast in the morning 4-8 mph with gusts to 15 mph...becoming south to southwest winds 10-20 mph with gusts up to 30 mph in the afternoon.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Terrain driven winds 3-7 mph in the morning...becoming southwest/upvalley 7-12 with gusts to 20 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Semi-stable in the morning with smoke settling becoming more unstable with day time heating. Smoke will linger through the day with light to moderate transport winds.

THURSDAY NIGHT FORECAST:

WEATHER: Mostly clear. Areas of smoke... especially deeper canyons and drainages.

MIN TEMPERATURES: 64-74.

MAX HUMIDITY: lower elevations 45-60%...upper valleys and higher elevation 25-40%

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP – Southwest to west in the evening 10-20 mph with gusts up to 25 mph...becoming north to northeast by morning 5-10 mph with gusts to 15 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Southwest/upslope in the evening 6-12 mph with gusts up to 20 mph...becoming Northeast/downslope by morning 3-7 mph.

Extended Outlook: Thursday through Sunday: A cooling trend can be expected through the period as the upper level high pressure weakens and onshore flow increases. In addition... there will be the possibility of some moisture from the remnants of Hurricane Jimena filtering into southern CA on Saturday and Sunday. If this moisture does move into the area... there might be a slight chance for showers and thunderstorms across the area. Temperatures will generally be in the upper 80s to upper 90s and slightly cooler on Saturday and Sunday. Daytime humidities will be wetter in the upper teens to lower 30%. Due to the increased onshore flow afternoon and evening gusty west to southwest winds 10 to 20 mph will continue. Gusts 30-40 mph may be possible over the highest peaks... especially the foothills of the Antelope Valley.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY

Refer to Weather Forecast for details: Mostly sunny. Areas of smoke. Max Temp: 84-103°. Min RH: 13-30%. Ridgetop Winds – NNE 5-10mph with gusts to 15 mph becoming SSW 12 – 20, gusts to 30 PM. Slope/Valley Winds – terrain 3-7 becoming SW or upvalley 8 – 15 with gusts to 20 mph in PM.

FUELS

Very heavy loading of decadent brush (chaparral, ceanothus, chemise, scrub oak, manzanita) (FM4, SH5, SH7) across the entire fire area, 15 foot high with Pine and Big Cone Doug Fir in the drainage bottoms and ridge tops above 4000'. The dead component in much for the brush exceeds 60%, heavy stands of grass are completely cured. Minimum fine fuel moisture: 3-5%, 1000 hour: 5-8%, Live fuel moisture: 60-65%. ERC's are running above 90%.

OUTPUTS - FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: Local Thresholds for active fire behavior: Winds (over 15 mph), RH (less than 25%), Temperature (over 90°) and BI (over 201). Predicted BI for today is 193 (down).

Yesterday fire behavior was very active to extreme in the Devil Canyon, Chilao and Magic Mt areas resulting in rapid rates of spread, fire whirls, spotting and convection column development. It should be noted that in all cases, the wind was not a significant contributor to the fire behavior. Fuels and slope were the drivers. Expect today's fire behavior to be similar to yesterday. In the AM, smoke will shade the fuels over much of the fire stunting the fires activity. Expect the smoke to begin lifting around 1000-1200 and fire activity to increase significantly in those areas under full sunshine. Be prepared for the winds to shift from NNE to SSW around 1000-1200 depending upon smoke coverage. Heavy smoke will delay this wind shift.

**Maximum Fire Behavior for Head fire under full sunshine: ROS 60-120 c/h, FL 30-60,
Spotting Distance 3/4 mile, Probability of Ignition 95% Backing fire: ROS 20-40 c/h, FL 8-15.**

SPECIFIC:

Branch I and II – For the divisions along the Foothill Drive corridor, the fire activity has diminished greatly as a result of the successful suppression efforts. Expect mostly backing fire with remote chance of upslope runs in unburned islands or as a result of burning operations.

Branch IV and V – Expect active fire behavior where wind and slope aligned with observed. Spotting likely but not profuse. Backing rates of spread will much slower, 2 to 4 chains per hour unless accelerated by channeled winds. Favorable conditions to hold and burnout in the morning. Winds and low RHs will test lines in the afternoon.

Branch XX – For the Mt Wilson area expect the main fire to connect with the burnout operations from yesterday. The fire the north of Mt Wilson has crossed the San Gabriel River in the area of Devore Campground and is poised to make a run upslope toward Nookum Pass. Should this occur, the SW winds should assist in limiting spot fires across the ridge top to the south.

In the Devil Canyon area, expect the fire to spread with active to extreme rates of spread and the potential for a defined convection column. Should this occurs be prepared for the column to collapse creating gusty and erratic winds.

FEEDBACK: Collect WX obs hourly and turn in to FBAN or IMET at end of shift. Include fire behavior.

AIR OPERATIONS

- Smoky conditions likely across the fire area until 1200 - 1400. Aviation operations will be limited.

SAFETY.

- Early detection of spot fires is critical for control and to provide an increase margin of safety.
- Watch out for downdrafts from the heavy helicopters increasing the fire behavior of upslope runs.

Items such as paint, varnish, pesticides, cleaners, batteries, automotive fluids and plastics can give off toxic vapors that can be very harmful.
- **Fire Behavior** – Expect the unexpected and be prepared to react accordingly. Review “Severe Fire Behavior Potential” (IRPG p.76). Monitor current weather conditions and forecasts.
- **Firing Operations/LCES** – Be aware of your surroundings during firing operations. Maintain situational awareness. Make sure everyone gets a thorough briefing and fully understands the complete plan.
- **Hydration** -- Drink water before, during and after shifts. Be alert for signs of dehydration and heat stress in yourself and others. Mix liquid intake at three waters to one sports drinks such as Gator Aide. Avoid energy drinks such as Red Bull, Nitro, etc. These will actually dehydrate you.

**Look Up, Look Down,
Look Around**

- ***Fuel Characteristics** – Assess prior to beginning operations.
 - ***Fuel Moisture** – Read daily shift plan and assess on site
 - ***Fuel Temperature** – Varies with exposure to direct sunlight.
 - ***Terrain & Fuel Accumulations** – Scout prior to beginning operations and during operations.
 - ***Wind** – Measure, observe, feel and notice changes.
 - ***Atmospheric Stability** – Observe.
 - ***Fire Behavior** – Monitor constantly prior to and during operations.
 - ***Safety** – Ask questions in unfamiliar situations.
- The only dumb question is the one that wasn't asked..

L.C.E.S

- **Lookouts**- Relative humidity is down and ignition probabilities up. Check your surroundings!
- **Communications**- Know your radio frequencies, and be cognizant of any problems with direct communications.
- **Escape Routes**- Know them, discuss them, and reassess them!
- **Safety Zones**- Evaluate the “black” as your safety zone. Reassess the problems.
- **HYDRATE, HYDRATE, HYDRATE!**

Power Line Hazards On Wildland Fires

- **Look Out** for power lines in, and around, the fire area.
 - Treat all downed wires as if energized. Downed wires can energize fences, equipment, phone lines, cable lines, etc.
- **Communicate** with your personnel, the location of power lines that are, or may be involved in the incident.
 - Contact Edison to report electrical facilities that are involved or damaged, and with a location for crews to respond.
- **Escape Routes** – **Do Not** identify escape routes that would take personnel under or near power lines!
 - Heat from extreme fire activity ionizes the air. Superheated, ionized air can act as a conductor, causing a line to arc to directly to ground.
 - Smoke, fire retardant, foam, or water can contaminate insulators, causing a power line to arc across insulators, through poles or towers to ground.
- **Safety Zones** – **Do Not** identify safety zones under or near power lines!
 - In addition to the arcing potential described for escape routes, “Fire Shelter” material is conductive and may attract an arc if a power line faults to ground due to direct, or near direct flame impingement.
 - Do not locate the ICP, or park equipment under power lines.
- **Extinguish pole fires when discovered.** This will help prevent “wire down” hazards that may block escape routes, equipment, or pose a hidden danger during mop up operations.
 - ◆ *Avoid applying water, foam, or gel above the first level of communication cables. If necessary, only use a water fog pattern on pole-top equipment.*
- **Air Operations** - Be aware of all power lines in and around the fire area, including skylines that run along the tops of transmission towers. Skylines are single, grounded, ¼” steel wires that are very easy to overlook in contrast to the larger conductors on the same tower.

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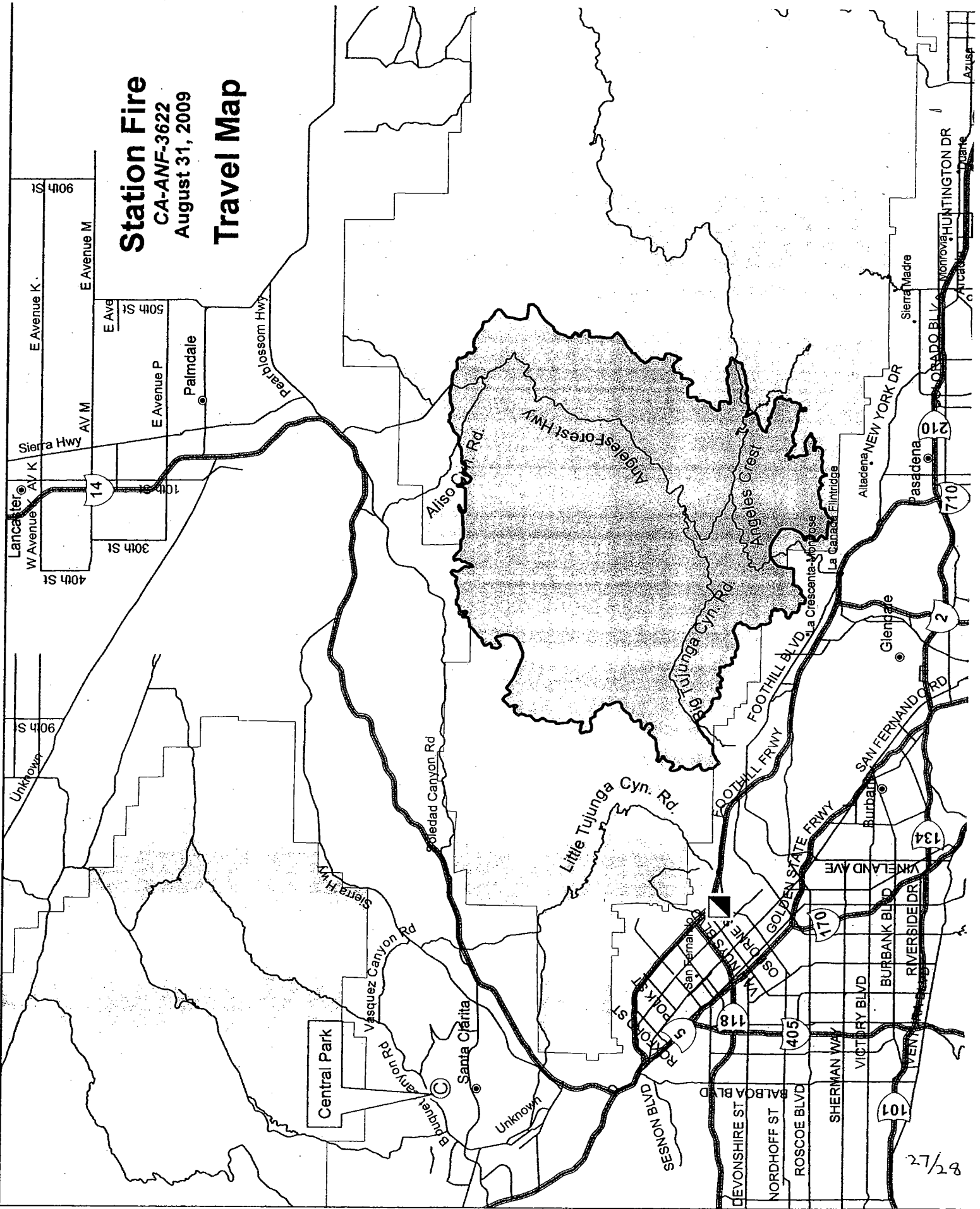
