




WEATHER DISCUSSION: A slight cooling trend will be noticed today as high pressure begins to slide eastward. However... afternoon temperatures will still mostly be in the 90s. Dry conditions will continue across the fire with afternoon readings falling into the teens and lower 20s. The wind pattern will continue to exhibit the usual diurnal trends... northerly/downvalley in the morning then becoming southwesterly/upvalley in the afternoon hours. Ridge tops may experience more northwest flow than the previous few days.

WEATHER FORECAST:

TODAY:

WEATHER: Mostly sunny. Areas of smoke.

MAX TEMPERATURES: Lower elevations 89-99
Upper elevations 84-90

24 HOUR CHANGE: cooler 1-3

MIN HUMIDITY: 13-28%

24 HOUR CHANGE: little

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP – Northwest to north in the morning 5-10 mph with gusts to 15 mph... becoming northwest to west in the afternoon 8-15 mph with gusts up to 25 mph in the afternoon.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Terrain driven winds 3-7 mph in the morning... becoming southwest/upvalley 7-12 with gusts to 20 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Semi-stable in the morning with smoke settling becoming marginally unstable with day time heating. Smoke will linger through the day with light to moderate transport winds.

FRIDAY NIGHT FORECAST:

WEATHER: Mostly clear. Areas of smoke... especially deeper canyons and drainages.

MIN TEMPERATURES: 58-68.

MAX HUMIDITY: lower elevations 40-55%... upper valleys and higher elevation 25-40%

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP – Southwest to west in the evening 5-15 mph with gusts up to 20 mph... becoming north to northwest by morning 5-10 mph with gusts to 15 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Southwest/upslope in the evening 6-12 mph with gusts up to 20 mph... becoming Northwest/downslope by morning 3-7 mph.

Extended Outlook: Saturday through Monday: A cooling trend is still on track as high pressure moves east and a trough of low pressure moves in from the Pacific. Afternoon high temperatures on Saturday will range from 88-96 at lower elevations to 78-88 at the ridgetops. By Sunday and Monday... temperatures will cool even further... ranging from 85-93 at lower elevations to 75-85 at the ridgetops. With the cooler temperatures... relative humidity will gradually increase through Monday. As for winds... expect some strongest southwesterly winds in the afternoon due to the strengthening onshore flow. Some of the windier areas... including the foothills of the Antelope Valley... could experience gusts of 35-40 mph.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY

Refer to Weather Forecast for details: Mostly sunny. Areas of smoke. Max Temp: 84-100°. Min RH: 13-30%. Ridgetop Winds – NNW 5-10mph with gusts to 15 mph becoming WNW 12 – 20, gusts to 30 PM. Slope/Valley Winds – terrain 3-7 becoming WNW or upvalley 8 – 15 with gusts to 20 mph in PM.

FUELS

Very heavy loading of decadent brush (chaparral, ceanothus, chemise, scrub oak, manzanita) (FM4, SH5, SH7) across the entire fire area, 15 foot high with Pine and Big Cone Doug Fir in the drainage bottoms and ridge tops above 4000'. The dead component in much for the brush exceeds 60%, heavy stands of grass are completely cured. Minimum fine fuel moisture: 3-5%, 1000 hour: 5-8%, Live fuel moisture: 60-65%. ERC's are running above 90%.

OUTPUTS - FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: Local Thresholds for active fire behavior: Winds (over 15 mph), RH (less than 25%), Temperature (over 90°) and BI (over 201). Predicted BI for today is 252 (up 59).

Yesterday fire behavior moderated a bit due to the smoky conditions over most of the fire area. The most active area of the fire was in the Devil's Canyon area where is made rapid upslope runs resulting in localized convection columns. The Chilao and Magic Mt areas were active but to a lesser extent, in part due to suppression efforts. Expect today's fire behavior to be similar to yesterday in the Devil's Canyon, with diminishing fire behavior in the Chilao and Magic Mt areas.

In the AM, smoke will shade the fuels over much of the fire stunting the fires activity. Expect the smoke to begin lifting around 1000-1200 and fire activity to increase in those areas under full sunshine. Be prepared for the winds to shift from NNE to SSW around 1000-1200 depending upon smoke coverage. Heavy smoke will delay this wind shift.

Maximum Fire Behavior for Head fire under full sunshine: ROS 60-120 c/h, FL 30-60, Spotting Distance 3/4 mile, Probability of Ignition 90% Backing fire: ROS 20-40 c/h, FL 8-15.

SPECIFIC:

Branch I and II – For the divisions along the **Foothill Drive corridor**, the fire activity has diminished greatly. Expect to find isolated areas of heat in the interior especially where fuels were heaviest.

In the **Mt Wilson area**, the fire has transitioned into a timber fuel model resulting in a significant reduction of the fire behavior. Expect the timbered, north aspect slopes to the north of Mt Wilson to burn with moderate fire behavior, ROS: 20-30c/h, FL: 2-10'. There is a chance the fire could make an upslope run from the San Gabriel drainage upslope to the ridge top. If this happens, the SW ridgetop winds will limit the potential of spot fires over the proposed containment line. These winds will also be favorable for burning ops.

Branch IV and V – Pacoima drainage: Favorable conditions will exist early in the period for holding and for burnout if any needs to be completed. After the evening wind shift, down slopes winds could press your lines and push fire back at your line. **Bare Mt:** Sparser fuels at lower elevations will make burnout difficult, higher on the slope, burnout in the timber should go well after the wind shift with favorable winds. Watch for wind eddies around side drainages and in Div FF.

Branch XX – In the **Devil Canyon area**, expect the fire to spread with active to extreme rates of spread and the potential for a defined convection column. Should this occurs be prepared for the column to collapse creating gusty and erratic winds.

AIR OPERATIONS

- Smoky conditions likely across the fire area until 1200 – 1400 and possibly longer.

SAFETY

- Monitor the weather frequently for changing conditions. The fire activity may be decreasing, but the threat for very active for behavior remains.

Pace yourselves. **Avoid “Energy Drinks” such as Red Bull, Monster, Rockstar, etc. These contain up to 5 times the amount of caffeine as coffee and strongly contribute to dehydration.**
- **Driving** – Drive defensively! When parking out on the line or on narrow roads, be sure there is enough room for even large apparatus to get by easily. Expect the unexpected around every curve. Drive with headlights on; use chock blocks; keep windshields clean; look before backing; and use backers whenever available. Drive at a speed so you can stop within one half of your visible distance. **Maintain Situational Awareness!**
- **Communications** – Give and receive clear instructions. If there is something you don't understand, get clarification. Maintain radio discipline; know exactly what you intend to say prior to keying the mike; and make messages short and concise.

DRIVING AND FATIGUE
