PILE SIZE: No larger than 6' x 6' x 6'. Smaller (4' x 4') is preferred.

WHERE TO PUT PILES:
 ---Build piles in conifer areas. AVOID building piles in hardwood or aspen patches.

---Do not build piles next to White Pine seedlings. These were intentionally planted several years ago. They are 1' to 2' tall and cannot survive intense heating.

---Build piles OUTSIDE THE CANOPY CROWN DRIPLINES. It is acceptable to cut balsam firs or hardwoods under 2" dbh if they occupy an otherwise good location for a pile.

---Build piles within the unit boundary only. Boundary trees are painted with range stripes.

WHAT TO PILE:
 ---Include needed branches when possible.
 ---Avoid placing logs >8" or large stumps into the piles, as these will burn for long duration with excessive heat, causing soil damage.
