Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Majority of growth in the heat perimeter is to the southeast with intense heat along the entire southern boundary. Multiple heat sources detected outside of the heat perimeter along the southern boundary. Two heat sources detected outside of the western boundary and six detected outside the eastern boundary. The hot spot to the north at headwaters of North Fork Kennally Creek has not grown significantly.
