Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Majority of growth in the heat perimeter is to the southeast in the headwaters of Powelson Creek, and to the east near Green Mountain. Intense heat along the entire southeastern and eastern boundary. Multiple heat sources detected outside of the heat perimeter on all sides of the fire. The hot spot to the north at headwaters of North Fork Kennally Creek has grown 9 acres and has intense heat on the eastern side, near Kennally Lakes.
