Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Plane and Tech were able to get some heat signatures on a second attempt – weather and clouds were causing issues.

I started with a fire perimeter provided by the incident. There was heat and some growth on the west side in section 18. Most of the intense heat was on the east side with some growth to the east and south in section 17. One addition fire poly spot outside the main fire perimeter is in the south west quarter of section 17 on the south fire perimeter.
