Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Fire is located in the Sawtooth National Forest in the headwaters of Grape Creek. It is bounded on the north by the ridge overlooking Independence Lakes. Cache Peak is to the west and Thunder Mountain is to the south. Northern perimeter has grown slightly since the last IR flight on 9/5. One isolated heat source was detected outside the perimeter in the saddle between Grape Creek and Green Creek; it is labeled on the map.
