Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Fire is located 5 miles northeast of Pine Valley, UT on the Dixie National Forest. Fire is situated on the west facing slope overlooking Main Canyon and crosses the Reservoir Canyon Trail. IR interpretation started with the 09/11 perimeter supplied by the incident. No areas of intense heat were detected, only isolated heat sources. None of the isolated heat sources detected were outside of the perimeter.
