Management Action Point 27
 Condition: Fire gets established west of constructed line adjoining N2 Div C and S2 Div B.
 Action:
 • Consider **Level 2 Evacuation** for East Garden Valley, Danskin Creek area.
 • Activate West Structure Group for protection in East Garden Valley. Work with Boise County Sheriff for further road closures to the west.

Management Action Point 50
 Condition: Fire crosses or is anticipated to cross MAP 50
 Action:
 • Consider **Level 2 Evacuation** of Long Creek summer homes
 • Consider **Level 2 Evacuation** of Park Creek Campground

Management Action Point 51
 Condition: Fire crosses or is anticipated to cross MAP 51.
 Action:
 • Consider **Level 2 Evacuation** of Long Creek summer homes
 • Consider **Level 2 Evacuation** of Park Creek Campground

Management Action Point 52
 Condition: Fire crosses and becomes established to the east of Forest Road 582 - Bear Valley Road
 Action:
 • Consider structure protection for values at risk along the Highway 21 corridor from FS road 582 (Bear Valley Rd) to FS road 526 (Five Mile Creek)
 • Continue communications with Boise County Sheriff regarding possible impact to highway and private structures
 • Continue communications with Idaho Power Company if there are possible impacts to powerlines within the highway corridor

Management Action Point 53
 Condition: Fire crosses or is anticipated to cross Lick Creek
 Action:
 • Consider Level 2 Evacuations for residences along Highway 21 corridor from Lick Creek to Upper Lowman area
 • Consider public safety along Highway 21 corridor, keep Boise County Sheriff informed of possible evacs, road closures
 • Provide structure protection for values at risk

Management Action Point 54
 Condition: Fire crosses or is anticipated to cross Fence Creek or Critical fire weather is anticipated to hit the fire area and active fire spread is expected to the east/southwest
 Action:
 • Consider Level 3 Evacuations in the Upper Lowman area as well as values along the Highway 21 corridor.
 • Contact Boise County Sheriff and update them on the situation
 • Provide for public safety along Highway 21 corridor

Management Action Point 55
 Condition: Fire crosses or is anticipated to expand north or MAP 55
 Action:
 • Consider **Level 2 Evacuation** for Middle Lowman area as well as values along the Highway 21 corridor.
 • Contact Boise County Sheriff and update them on the situation
 • Provide for public safety along Highway 21 corridor

Management Action Points

Management Action Point 8
 Condition: Fire continues to spread north of Highway 17 and is anticipated to spread east towards Lowman
 Action:
 • Continue communications with Boise County Sheriff, Lowman District Ranger (John Kidd), Idaho City District Ranger (Brent Peterson) and Pioneer Incident Commander the need to implement Level 3 Evacuations within impacted area.
 • Request Lownan Fire Department provide structural protection resources.
 • Request Boise County Emergency Coordinator notify Idaho Department of Lands of the fire threat to structures and possible need to order a Strike Team of structural engines.
 • Contact Idaho Power Company that there may be a need to de-energize powerlines within the Lowman area
 • Consider level 1 evacuation from Deadwood River confluence north to Long Creek Summer homes then south to Old Ranger Station Road Helport.
 • Evaluate the need to expand Pioneer Fire Closure Order to the north on the Lowman/Emmett Ranger Districts.
 • Consider structure protection for Deadwood lookout
 • Consider public safety and protection of infrastructure at Park Creek Campground

Management Action Point 9
 Condition: Fire becomes established north of Forest Service Road 385.
 Spatial - Fire becomes established to the east of MAP 71
 Temporal - Shrub/Grass component becomes available to support active fire spread
 Action:
 • Consider public safety along Highway 21 corridor and within Archie Creek. Evaluate the need for **Level 1 Evacuation**
 • Evaluate structure protection needs for Highway 21 corridor from Lowman to Forest Service Road 382 (Archie Creek)
 • Evaluate and consider structure protection for Archie Creek
 Consider public safety:
 • Highway 21
 • South Fork of the Payette River
 Kirikham Campground

Management Action Point 20
 Condition: Fire becomes established or is anticipated to cross MAP 20
 Action:
 • Consider **Level 1 Evacuation** for structures on Hwy 17 from Forest Service Road 555 to Forest Service Road 382
 • Consider public safety on Highway 17. Recommend Highway closure from Forest Service Road 382, east to Lowman.
 Make contact with Idaho Power Company to de-energize powerlines on along Hwy 17 if threatened

Management Action Point 21
 Condition: Fire becomes established or is anticipated to cross MAP 21
 Action:
 • Consider **Level 2 Evacuation** for structures on Hwy 17 from Forest Service Road 555 to Forest Service Road 382
 • Consider public safety on Highway 17. Recommend Highway closure from Forest Service Road 382, east to Lowman.
 Make contact with Idaho Power Company to de-energize powerlines on along Hwy 17 if threatened

Management Action Point 22
 Condition: Fire becomes established or is anticipated to cross MAP 22
 Action:
 • Consider **Level 1 Evacuation** for structures on Hwy 17 from Forest Service Road 555 to Forest Service Road 382
 • Consider public safety on Highway 17. Recommend Highway closure from Forest Service Road 382, east to Lowman.
 Make contact with Idaho Power Company to de-energize powerlines on along Hwy 17 if threatened

Management Action Point 23
 Condition: Fire becomes established or is anticipated to cross MAP 23
 Action:
 • Consider **Level 1 Evacuation** for Pioneerville
 • Consider structure protection for homes in Grimes Pass area

Management Action Point 24
 Condition: Fire becomes established or is anticipated to cross MAP 24
 Action:
 • Consider **Level 2 Evacuation** for Pioneerville
 • Consider structure protection for homes in Grimes Pass area

Management Action Point 25
 Condition: Fire becomes established or is anticipated to cross MAP 25
 Action:
 • Consider **Level 3 Evacuation** for Pioneerville
 • Consider structure protection for homes in Grimes Pass area

Management Action Point 26
 Condition: Fire gets established north of highway 17, west of current fire perimeter. Spotting over this MAP is likely if fire gets established to the west of Little Hole in the Wall Creek on the south side of the river.
 Action:
 • Continue providing structure protection for Deadwood Lookout
 • Consider providing structure protection for Scott Mountain Lookout
 • Consider providing protection for BGR microwave communications site for Deadwood Dam

Management Action Point 27
 Condition: Fire crosses or is anticipated to cross Chapman Creek
 Action:
 • Consider Level 3 Evacuations for Warm Springs (Valley Road) + Consider level 2 evacuations for Grandjean area (FS Road 524) + Consider public safety on Highway 21
 • Consider public safety on Highway 21
 • Consider providing structure protection for Ten Mile Summer homes
 • Consider providing structure protection for Sunset Mountain Lookout
 • Consider public safety on Hwy 21 south of Mores Creek Summit
