## Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

The Roaring fire showed more activity and intense heat tonight than it has in the past couple IR scans.

Growth continues to the south, where intense heat was mapped along with perimeter growth on both the north and south side of McGuire Lake. Two additional spot fires were mapped about 6 chains south of the main fire perimeter on the steep, southeast facing slope in the drainage flowing from Pollywog Lake.

The fire also continues to advance to the west, on the slopes above Roaring Creek in section 21. Here, the fire has advanced downslope nearly <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> mile since the previous IR flight.

Very little heat was observed along the eastern flank of the fire with only a handful of isolated heat sources in this portion of the fire area.
