Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Fire is located just south of the Bonneville and Caribou County line at the head of Marshall Canyon, 2 miles east of Tincup Mountain and 1.5 miles north of Tincup Creek and Highway 34. Intense heat detected along the western and southern perimeter. Hot spots outside the perimeter to the east and west.
