Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Fire is located just south of the Bonneville and Caribou County line at the head of Marshall Canyon, 2 miles east of Tincup Mountain and 1 mile north of Tincup Creek and Highway 34. Intense heat detected along both sides of Marshall Canyon, and to the west in Corral Creek watershed. Isolated heat sources were detected outside the perimeter along both sides of Marshall Canyon.
