Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Fire is primarily located on the Wasatch National Forest. However, it has left the forest on the western and northern flanks. It has reached Red Pine Mountain to the east and West Government Creek to the south. Areas of intense heat are located along the northeaster perimeter where multiple isolated heat sources were detected outside of the perimeter.
