Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Fire is primarily located on the Wasatch National Forest. However, it has left the forest on the western and northern flanks. It has reached Red Pine Mountain to the east and West Government Creek to the south. Tonight's IR started with incident's perimeter from 09/08. The growth in the perimeter is on the northeast flank of Red Pine Mountain where intense and scattered heat were detected. There were no isolated heat sources detected outside the perimeter. The majority of isolated heat was in the northeast but there was isolated heat detected near Copper Spring.
