Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Fire is primarily located on the Wasatch National Forest. However, it has left the National Forest on the western and northern flanks. It has reached Red Pine Mountain to the east and West Government Creek to the south. Tonight's IR started with IR perimeter from 09/09. The growth in the perimeter is on the northeast flank of Red Pine Mountain where there is a 1.5 acre hot spot. Intense and scattered heat were detected in the headwaters of Little Red Pine Creek. There is one isolated heat source detected approximately 1.3 miles outside the perimeter and it is labeled on the map.
