Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Used IR perimeter 20170804@0253 to start interpretation. Growth since last IR is primarily to the west on the main fire and to the SE on the spot fire across Camas Creek. Multiple isolated heat sources were detected to the SE of the main fire on the slope leading down to Camas Creek and along Camas Creek, just downstream of its confluence with Macarte Creek. It could not be determined if the perimeter had reached the Camas Creek.
