

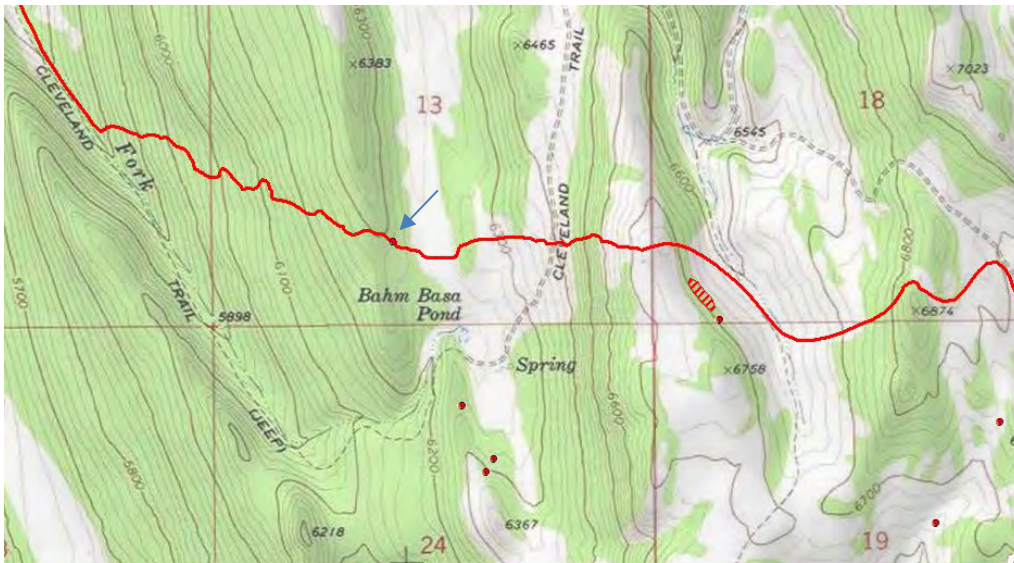

Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Started with fire perimeter provided by incident dated and time stamped at 20180723 @ 1900 with starting acres of 5,351.

No growth. There was an isolated heat source located on the northeast side of the fire that showed to be on the line or just out of the fire perimeter. It is in section 13 north of the Bahm Basa Pond and west of the Cleveland Trail at -116.084706, 41.968796.



There were just a couple of small islands of intense heat, otherwise just a few scattered isolated heat sources.

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
