

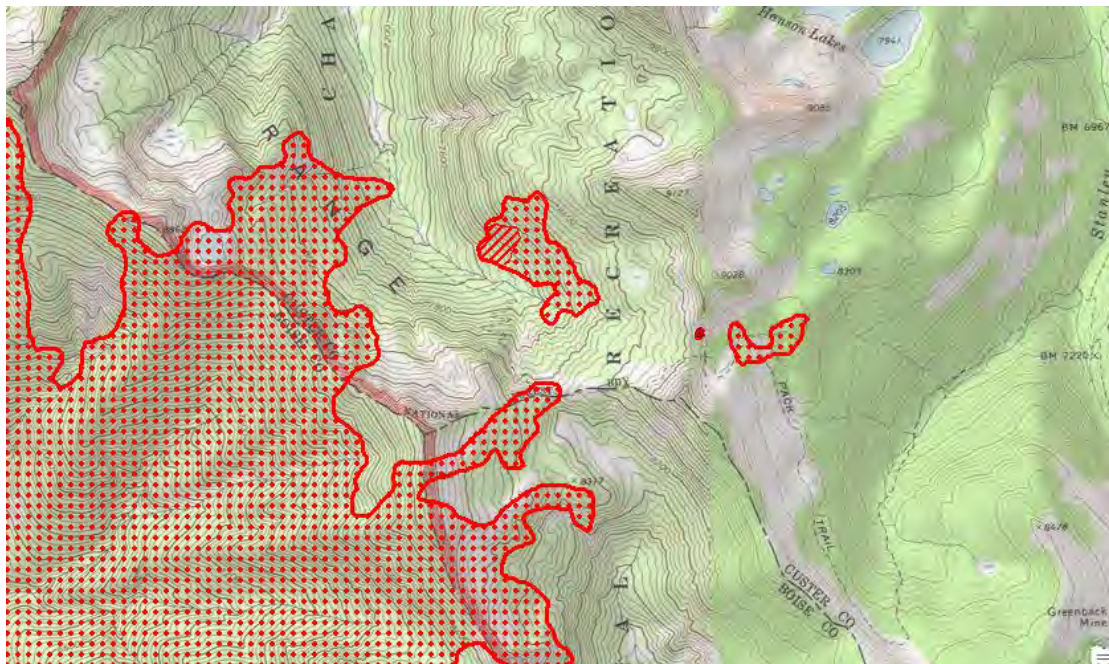

Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Started interpretation from fire perimeter pulled from WFDSS – starting acres was 3,151. Growth – 2,339 Acres.

There was some light scattered clouds over the fire which did block some heat signatures. Starting with the WFDSS perimeter, all the heat was on the east side of the fire with a couple heat polygons outside the main heat perimeter on each side of the Custer and Boise county line.



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All of the growth of the fire was on the east half of the fire.
