Weather Concerns (synopsis of current and predicted weather; discuss related factors that may cause concern): 24 to 96 hrs: High pressure will continue to dominate the overall weather pattern into early next week. A weak upper-level disturbance will bring increased northwest winds with gusts near 25 mph. RH will drop into the 15-20% range each afternoon. An inversion developing each night will keep ridgetops warmer and drier with poorer overnight recoveries in the 35-45% range. | 12 hours: | <p>Moderate fire behavior near the DIV B/C break northwest of Cotton Ridge, east of Trail Canyon, and along Third Fork Rock Creek where crews have been performing small-scale burnout operations. Areas of isolated heat within the interior remains south of Cotton Ridge and in the Telephone Canyon area of DIVs B and C. Pockets of isolated heat is present throughout the southern half of the fire's footprint.</p> |
| 24 hours: | <p>Same As Above</p> |
| 48 hours: | <p>An upper-level disturbance will pass through the fire area bringing an increase in winds with gusts up to 25 mph that may increase fire behavior in areas of unburned fuels.</p> |
| 72 hours: | <p>An inversion each night will keep ridgetops warmer and drier with poor overnight recoveries. Poor recoveries will be followed by warm, dry afternoons that have the potential to support continued burning of available fuels.</p> |

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| 37. | <p>Strategic Objectives (define planned end-state for incident): Following the incident objectives developed during the WFDSS process and in line with the Delegation of Authority strategic objectives are as follows (clockwise from north):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -NORTH of Mahogany Butte to protect grazing allotments, private inholdings, and cultural and natural resources. -EAST of FSR 542 and FSR 541, Deadline Ridge, and Rock Creek to protect vacation homes, Magic Mountain Ski Resort, improved campgrounds, grazing allotments, private inholdings, and cultural and natural resources. -SOUTH of County Road E2900N and County Road E 3000 N to protect residences, grazing allotments, and cultural and natural resources. |
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DIV B: Resources will mop up, hold, and patrol secured fireline following recent burnout operations.

DIV C: Resources in the southern portion of the division near the B/C break will hold secured fire line following recent burnout operations. Northern portion of the division suppression repair continues. Continued mop up and patrolling of fireline from Sagehen Flats through to Buck Brush Flats and south from Buck Brush Flats to Magpie Basin along Rock Creek Road.

Repair Group: The repair group will continue rehabilitating and stabilizing dozer line, and repairing roads that were damaged during suppression actions.
