## Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

I began mapping from the previous night's IR perimeter.

The NIFS Wildfire Daily Fire Perimeter was last updated based on the 9/25/2021 @ 1947 IR.

The heat perimeter expanded by 969 acres in the past 24 hours.

There were two isolated heats outside the heat perimeter. One on the north flank appeared to be associated with a hot spring. The other was 3.5 miles distant from the western flank @  $115^{\circ}24'38.566"W$   $44^{\circ}36'22.908"N$
