Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Tonight's mapping used the previous night's IR as a base for mapping.

Very little perimeter growth was mapped this shift, with 23 acres added in the area southeast of Bull Mountain.

No intense heat was mapped along the fire's perimeter, though significant areas of scattered heat were mapped along the fire's eastern edge.

The fire's southern portion (south of Halfway Camp) had no intense or scattered heat but continues to display many isolated heat sources.
