The heat perimeter continues to grow. Previous IR acres 7,986 mapped 8,208 acres in the extending to the east and southwest. Potential heat source @ 44° 29' 31.39494000" N 116° 05' 18.46725720" W Still a lot of intense heat along entire perimeter. Lots of scattered heat throughout the interior. Lots of small area outside main perimeter along the east and south borders.
