Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Fire continues to be active. Started interpretation with NIFS Wildfire Event Poly pulled 08/23/2022 @ 2212 MDT Incident made adjustments to fire line based on walk around/handline along div A & R & DP3. The heat perimeter continues to grow. Previous IR acres 8,208 mapped 8,357 acres. East perimeter continues to move toward the lake and south toward Bed Ground Creek. Pretty good patch of perimeter growth on the west side near Lost Fork Creek with intense heat. Still a lot of intense heat along entire perimeter. Lots of scattered heat throughout the interior as well as lots of isolated heat within perimeter.
