Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Fire continues to be active. Started interpretation with NIFS Wildfire Event Poly pulled 08/24/2022 @ 2355 MDT Incident made adjustments to fire line based on walk around/handline perimeter. The heat perimeter continues to grow. Previous IR acres 8,357 mapped 8,753 acres. SE Perimeter is seeing lots of activity as expected per GISS on incident. Growth on the southern tip of perimeter toward Wilson Peak. There large areas is intense heat along these areas as well. Dense scattered heat behind areas of intense heat. Areas closer to interior are light scattered heat. Isolated heat mapped as will with one point about .90 mile from that southeast border and west of Campbell Creek @ 116.1336405°W 44.4836538°N North.
