Previous IR acres 8,753 mapped 9,206 acres. SE, SW and East Perimeter seeing lots of activity as expected per GISS on incident. Growth on the southern tip of perimeter toward Wilson Peak. There are large areas of intense heat along these areas as well. Small area of growth in the NE corner toward lake north of Silver Creek Dense scattered heat behind areas of intense heat around the perimeter. Light scattered heat in the interior.
