Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Started interpretation with NIFS Wildfire Event Poly pulled 08/28/2022 @ 2348 MDT The heat perimeter continues to grow. Previous IR acres 11,345 mapped 11,755 acres. SE, SW and East Perimeter seeing lots of activity as expected per GISS on incident. Growth along the SW perimeter where burn out has occurred. Still lots of intense heat and dense scattered heat in southern portion of the incident. Scattered heat within the central portion of perimeter is less dense than that along the southern/eastern boundary. NW portion appears to be cooling a bit with mostly isolated heat showing up. Several small areas of heat to the east of perimeter out ahead of the growth in that area. Isolated heat source showed up again tonight near Four Bit Creek (possible campfire)
