Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Started interpretation with NIFS Wildfire Event Poly pulled 08/30/2022 @ 2200 MDT The heat perimeter continues to grow. Previous IR acres 12,078 mapped 12,398 acres. South and East Perimeter seeing lots of activity as expected per GISS on incident. Growth along the SW perimeter where burn out has occurred. East side of perimeter is still very hot with large areas of intense heat. Constructed fireline appears to be holding the along the eastern side of perimeter. Small interior islands continue to merge together. NW portion continues to cool with mostly isolated heat showing up.
