Welcome to the Moose Incident

LEADER'S INTENT:

Incident responders have a DUTY to safeguard each other and the public we serve from hazards. It is through RESPECT for everyone's health and safety that we apply a risk management process to inform our actions. In addition to the operational risks associated with wildland fires, we also have the Covid-19 pandemic to be concerned with. To safeguard ourselves, co-workers, and the community it is important follow the mitigations identified below. We rely on everyone's INTEGRITY to ensure compliance for the sake of our health and success in our mission.

Covid-19 prevention and mitigation guidance for individuals, regardless of vaccination status, includes:

- The Module as One concept should be used by crews and modules to the extent practical. This reduces potential exposure to Covid-19 from outside resources and the public.
- All incident personnel are expected to conduct self-screening of their health on a daily basis. Anyone experiencing sickness/ illness should contact their supervisor and see the Medical Unit or Covid coordinator personnel for assessment.
- Face coverings are to be available in any enclosed incident indoor facility or common use area regardless of proximity to others. When worn, masks need to cover the nose and mouth securely.
- The local communities will appreciate your use of masks when shopping at local businesses.

Great Basin Team 1 has a zero tolerance policy for bullying, sexual harassment, illegal drug and alcohol use.

ICP AND CAMPS

- Access into ICP and some base camp facilities may be restricted to essential personnel only, i.e. module supervisors and trainees.
- To promote isolation and social distancing, operational resources will be assigned to camps and spike camps dispersed on the incident.
- Food will be individually packaged. Food will be pre-packaged for pick-up from the caterer at Base Camp or delivered to drop points and camps for distribution. Special dietary needs should be reported to your line supervisor.
- Daily operational briefings will be conducted via radio or virtually. Only supervisors and trainees should attend in-person briefings.

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Hot and dry conditions return for both today and tomorrow. Monday wind will be much gustier than today's. The next threat of showers and thunderstorms returns Wednesday and Thursday.

WEATHER FORECAST:

WEATHER: Sunny, except for smoke.

TEMPERATURE: Ridge high 70 to 78. Valley high 79 to 87.

HUMIDITY: Ridge minimum 13 to 19 percent. Valley minimum 13 to 23 percent.

20 FT WIND:

RIDGETOP – Variable up to 4 mph, by 1400 becoming west 2 to 6 mph gusts to 10 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Down valley/downslope up to 3 mph, becoming upslope/up valley 2 to 6 mph gusts to 10 mph.

HAINES INDEX: 4 Low

LIGHTNING ACTIVITY LEVEL: 1.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Inversion top at 6800ft elevation, rising to 4400ft to 7400ft AGL. Inversion breaking around 1300. Afternoon transport wind west 6 mph.

OUTLOOK FOR TONIGHT: Clear, except for smoke. Low temperature: Ridges 48 to 56. Valleys 46 to 54. Maximum humidity: Ridges 34 to 44 percent. Valleys 46 to 56 percent. Ridge wind west northwest 1 to 5 mph, by 2200 becoming south 1 to 4 mph. Valley wind up valley/upslope 1 to 4 mph, becoming downslope/down valley 1 to 5 mph. Haines Index 4 Low. LAL 1. Inversion top around 6800ft elevation.

OUTLOOK FOR MONDAY: Sunny, except for smoke. High temperature: Ridges 75 to 83. Valleys 84 to 94. Minimum humidity: Ridges 12 to 19 percent. Valleys 12 to 20 percent. Ridge wind southwest 2 to 7 mph gusts to 12 mph, by 1400 becoming northwest 6 to 12 mph gusts to 22 mph. Valley wind down valley/downslope 1 to 4 mph, becoming upslope/up valley 5 to 11 mph gusts to 20 mph.

EXTENDED FORECAST: Mon night/Tue/Tue night: Mostly clear/mostly sunny. Low 52 to 62. High 81 to 95. Tue night low 56 to 66. Little change in afternoon humidity. Afternoon ridge wind east 2 to 7 mph gusts to 12 mph. Wed: Partly sunny with a chance of thunderstorms. High 78 to 92. Higher afternoon humidity. Afternoon ridge wind northwest 2 to 6 mph gusts to 10 mph. Wed night: Mostly cloudy and a slight chance of thunderstorms. Low 54 to 64. Thu: Partly sunny. A chance of thunderstorms. High 74 to 88. Even higher humidity. Afternoon ridge wind southwest 2 to 6 mph gusts to 10 mph.

WEATHER SUMMARY: *See incident forecast for specifics.*

Day: Temp 67 - 7° Ridges RH 21 - 29% **Winds:** NW 5 -11 mph G20 mph

Night: Temp 43-53° RH 38 - 48% **Winds:** Ridge NW 2-8 G14, becoming east 2-6

OUTPUTS

GENERAL:

In the higher elevations the fire is predominately burning in mixed conifer with light to moderate dead and down surface fuels (FM10/TU5). Low to moderate fire behavior expected, surface fire and occasional torching with potential for short-range spots. In areas where wind and fuels align with terrain expect uphill runs. If the inversion at 6800' persists through early afternoon, fire activity is expected to be low until the inversion breaks.

In the lower elevations the fire is predominately burning in grass and shrub (GS2). Expect moderate rates of spread with wind alignment. Slope reversals possible. Interior pockets will continue to burn out as fuels become more available.

SPECIFIC:

Div A/F/K: Low fire behavior and minimal activity expected. Smoldering persists in the riparian area along Hwy. 93 and pockets of heavier fuels continue to consume.

Div M: Low to moderate activity expected. Fuels in the Diamond Creek area will continue to smolder and burn out. Individual tree torching possible. Spotting potential low.

Div T/O: Continued activity in timber fuels with short range spotting possible. Fire activity expected to continue in the Jackass Ridge, Moose Creek, Haystack Mountain areas.

Div X: Low to moderate fire activity expected, backing and flanking and some torching possible. In the German gulch area slope reversal possible.

Night Ops: Low fire behavior and minimal activity expected.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Thermal inversion should lift by 1300, winds light and variable.

SAFETY: **Fatigue is building and probability of ignition is increasing, don't let your guard down. Maintain your situational awareness and utilize the risk management process.**

What is Probability of Ignition (PI)?

It is the rating of the probability that a *glowing firebrand* will cause a fire, providing it lands on receptive fuels. It is not related to the likelihood of a firebrand being produced, or if the firebrand will be the right size or shape to be transported by convection and/or winds; nor if there are available fuels where it lands. This means that if the probability of ignition is 60% and 10 glowing firebrands land on receptive fuels, i.e., grass, needles, punky wood, then there will be 6 ignitions. Probability of ignition relates only to the chance of initial ignition. For this ignition to grow into a wildfire, the firebrand must stay lit and land in a fuel bed susceptible to burning. Probability of ignition is estimated from the current temperature, shading from either forest canopy or cloud cover and 1-hr fuel moisture content.



Moose Fire Initial Attack Responsibility and Procedures

The following applies to all IA responses:

- Relay the initial coordinates and size up information (if applicable) to the **MOOSE** Fire Communications Unit
- The Communications Unit will take the coordinates to the Situation Unit to plot and determine if the new start is in, or out of the IA responsibility area.
- The Communications Unit will notify Planning Operations of the potential new IA.
- If requested, the Planning Operations Chief will update the jurisdictional Duty Officer.
- The Communications Unit will notify the jurisdictional dispatch office of the new start and provide them an initial size-up and inform them of the resources responding
- In all cases, the IA will be documented using the appropriate Incident Organizer and be given to the local agency representative upon arrival on scene, in camp or sent to the respective dispatch center

Fires within the IA Responsibility Area:

- All communications will be handled through the incident Communications Unit
- The initial size up will be relayed to Line Ops who will send appropriate identified resources
- All requests for additional resources must be approved by Line Ops
- Great Basin Team 1 will manage the fire until it is suppressed completely, turned over to local resources, or the agency administrator makes a different decision regarding its management
- If the Jurisdictional Dispatch Center identifies a potential new start within the delegated incident IA response area, the center will notify **MOOSE** Fire communications and all above procedures will be implemented.

Fires outside the IA Responsibility Area:

- The respective dispatch center will dispatch resources to the fire per dispatch procedures unless otherwise requested by the Duty Officer for the jurisdictional Agency
- The jurisdictional duty officer may request team resources (aviation or ground) through the **MOOSE** Fire Communications Unit as approved by Line Operations.
- If **MOOSE** Fire resources are utilized, and arrive on-scene first, they will provide a size up to the incident communications unit. Communications unit will provide intel/information to the jurisdictional dispatch center.
- The dispatch center will provide the air-to-air frequency to all dispatched aviation resources to communicate with air attack.
- Jurisdictional responding ground resources will be given the frequencies to the **MOOSE** incident in the event there are resources responding from the **MOOSE** Fire, to provide positive communications with all respondents.
- Aviation resources may go direct to the dispatch center for their notification and size up but must also notify the incident communications unit in coordination with the incident air attack.
