



- MAP 1: WUI Corridor from Wallace Creek to Salmon**
 Condition: If fire becomes established east of MAP 1.
 Description: MAP 1 is the Diamond Creek Control Line north of Wallace Creek near the Salmon River. West to the Ridge Road containing the Williams Creek Summit.
 Actions:
 1. Operations notifies Lemoore County Sheriff to issue evacuation notices if fire conditions warrant closure of Highway 93.
 2. Operations implements structure protection measures based on plans, fire behavior and personal safety.
 3. Lemoore County Sheriff and Salmon City officials and BLM Salmon Field Office are aware of the fire.
 4. LEMOORE County may assist with fire behavior projections regarding when/where impacts might occur.
 Resources:
 Lemoore County: Sheriff's Office, IOT, Safety Officer.
 Operational Resources includes 20 Engines, 5 water tenders, 4 Dozers, 3 HC, 2 Type 2 IA Crews, 3 Tank Force Leaders, 3 Type 1 Helicopters, and 1 Air Attack/HCCO. Additional resource needs may be required as complexity escalates.
- MAP 2: WUI Corridor north of North Fork**
 Condition: If fire becomes established north of MAP 2.
 Description: MAP 2 follows the west side of Highway 93 north from North Fork and turns west at the Hill Creek Road.
 Actions:
 1. In consultation with Operations, Lemoore County Sheriff to issue evacuation notices if fire conditions warrant closure of Highway 93.
 2. Operations implements structure protection measures based on plans, fire behavior and personal safety.
 3. Lemoore County Sheriff and Salmon City officials and BLM Salmon Field Office are aware of the fire.
 4. LEMOORE County may assist with fire behavior projections regarding when/where impacts might occur.
 Resources:
 Lemoore County: Sheriff's Office, IOT, Safety Officer.
 Operational Resources includes 20 Engines, 5 water tenders, 4 Dozers, 3 HC, 2 Type 2 IA Crews, 3 Tank Force Leaders, 3 Type 1 Helicopters, and 1 Air Attack/HCCO. Additional resource needs may be required as complexity escalates.
- MAP 3: Notifi Bitterroot National Forest**
 Condition: If fire becomes established north of MAP 3.
 Description: MAP 3 follows the ridge line from the Bitterroot National Forest, east to Ditcher Mountain, Bald Mountain, Indian Peak, and ending at Granite Mountain.
 Actions:
 1. LEMOORE County may assist with fire behavior projections regarding when/where impacts might occur.
 2. Lemoore County Sheriff to issue evacuation notices if fire conditions warrant closure of Highway 93.
 3. The Forest will consider expanding the planning boundary to include the Bitterroot National Forest and coordinate with them about additional values on the Bitterroot NF.
 4. Forest will assess Planning Area and evaluate additional values and needs on the Salmon-Challis north of MAP 3.
 Resources:
 Lemoore County: Forest Staff, LEMOORE County Sheriff's Office.
 Operational Resource needs will be determined given fire location, fuels, topography, and values. Risk to personnel will be a factor in determining actions.
- MAP 4: ESA Fish Tributaries**
 Condition: As suppression actions are developed, care must be taken to avoid negative suppression impacts to fish habitat in identified tributaries on all watersheds.
 Description: This is a spatially explicit map that shows the ESA species of fish habitat in WUI areas to be aware of suppression planning in sensitive areas.
 Actions:
 1. Operations consults with Lead READ when planning suppression activities in ESA Fish Tributaries as identified in WUISS (not just US Forest Service lands).
 2. Operations assesses potential impacts to fish habitat and safety is at risk. Record use of retardant in these streams and notify READ.
 3. Operations considers potential impacts to fish habitat and safety is at risk. Record use of retardant in these streams and notify READ.

 Resources:

- MAP 5: Salmon Municipal Watershed**
 Condition: Fire crosses MAP 5 and becomes established.
 Description: MAP 5 follows the Ridge Road from the west end of the Diamond Control Line near Wallace Creek, west to the Ridge Road, and the 302 road south to the Williams Creek Summit.
 Actions:
 1. High intensity fire on the forested slopes in the upper reaches of Polled, Chips, and Jesse Creeks may result in high sediment flows that could negatively impact the Salmon municipal water system by a long duration. Fire on lower slopes may have grasslands and shrubs and not result in as much sediment as the watershed although best land management practices and principles.
 2. LEMOORE County may assist with fire behavior projections regarding when/where impacts might occur and communicate to Operations.
 3. Operations assesses potential impacts and protection measures to Bear Track Mine site infrastructure and the historic Lemoore tunnel (no residents).

 Operational Resource needs will be determined given fire location, fuels, topography, and values. Risk to personnel will be a factor in determining actions.
- MAP 6: Mine Power Line (4 mi buffer)**
 Condition: Fire crosses MAP 6 and becomes established.
 Description: MAP 6 is a line buffered 4 miles north of the powerline to the Blackfoot Mine.
 Actions:
 1. Loss of power will threaten Blackfoot and Bear Track mine wastewater filtration, potentially poisoning the stream and having long term ecological and economic impacts. People work at both mine sites and travel daily. Based on expected fire behavior and fuel conditions.
 2. LEMOORE County may assist with fire behavior projections regarding when/where impacts might occur and communicate to Operations.
 3. Operations assesses potential impacts and protection measures to Bear Track Mine site infrastructure and the historic Lemoore tunnel (no residents).
 4. Operations assesses potential impacts and protection measures to Bear Track Mine site infrastructure and the historic Lemoore tunnel (no residents).
 5. LEMOORE County may assist with fire behavior projections regarding when/where impacts might occur and communicate to Operations.

- MAP 7: Mine Power Line (1.5 mi buffer)**
 Condition: Fire crosses MAP 7 and becomes established.
 Description: MAP 7 is a line buffered 1.5 miles north of the powerline to the Blackfoot Mine.
 Actions:
 1. Loss of power will threaten the mine's ability to filter wastewater; this will poison the stream and kill fish, having long term ecological and economic impacts. Based on expected fire behavior and fuel conditions.
 2. Operations and the Lemoore County Sheriff will coordinate to notify the Power Company to shut down operations if necessary and communicate the fire location to the power company.
 3. Operations will assess potential impacts and protection measures to Bear Track Mine site infrastructure and the historic Lemoore tunnel (no residents).
 4. Operations assesses potential impacts and protection measures to Bear Track Mine site infrastructure and the historic Lemoore tunnel (no residents).
 5. LEMOORE County may assist with fire behavior projections regarding when/where impacts might occur and communicate to Operations.

- MAP 8: Blackfoot Mine Access**
 Condition: This is an east line buffered 2 miles north of the access road from Salmon to Blackfoot Mine, which goes east to west following Williams Creek Road, Dooey Creek Rd, Panther Creek Rd to Blackfoot Creek Road.
 Actions:
 1. Maintaining traffic flow is critical to the local economy and could generate fire safety concerns; operations actions to keep the road to Blackfoot Mine open, based on projected fire spread and behavior.
 2. Lemoore County Sheriff will coordinate with the Sheriff to plan for and implement road closures and evacuations.
 3. Operations assesses potential impacts and protection measures to Bear Track Mine site infrastructure and the historic Lemoore tunnel (no residents).
 4. Operations assesses potential impacts and protection measures to Bear Track Mine site infrastructure and the historic Lemoore tunnel (no residents).
 5. LEMOORE County may assist with fire behavior projections regarding when/where impacts might occur and communicate to Operations.

- MAP 9: Panther Creek Closure and WUI**
 Condition: Fire crosses MAP 9 and becomes established.
 Description: MAP 9 is a north-south line buffered 2 miles east of the northern portion of Panther Creek Road and extends from the Salmon River, south to Nagas Creek.
 Actions:
 1. Operations and the Lemoore County Sheriff will coordinate with the Sheriff to plan for and implement road closures and evacuations.
 2. Operations assesses potential impacts and protection measures to Bear Track Mine site infrastructure and the historic Lemoore tunnel (no residents).
 3. Operations assesses potential impacts and protection measures to Bear Track Mine site infrastructure and the historic Lemoore tunnel (no residents).
 4. LEMOORE County may assist with fire behavior projections regarding when/where impacts might occur and communicate to Operations.
 5. Forest will assess system Planning Area boundary, values, and need for additional resources.
 6. Evaluate the access for river permits along the main Salmon and Middle Fork to determine quantity of entry and exit permit holders (Black Shaded Forest Decisions) if Panther Creek Road will be closed, the River Road is the only access point for permit holders.
 7. Lemoore County will notify stakeholders.
 Resources:
 Lemoore County: Sheriff's Office, Safety Officer.
 Operational Resources includes 20 Engines, 3 water tenders, 2 HC, 2 Type 2 IA Crews, 3 Tank Force Leaders, 3 Type 1 Helicopters, and 1 Air Attack/HCCO. Additional resource needs may be required as complexity escalates.
- MAP 10: Notifi Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest**
 Condition: If fire becomes established east of MAP 10.
 Description: MAP 10 extends north to south approximately 2 miles west of the Beaverhead-Deerlodge NF boundary.
 Actions:
 1. Based on time of year and projected fire spread, consider notification to the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest for potential spread onto their administrative area.
 2. LEMOORE County may assist with fire behavior projections regarding when/where impacts might occur.
 3. Lemoore County Sheriff to issue evacuation notices if fire conditions warrant closure of Highway 93.
 4. The Forest will consider expanding the planning boundary to include the Beaverhead-Deerlodge NF and coordinate with them about additional values on the Beaverhead-Deerlodge NF.
 5. Forest will assess Planning Area and evaluate additional values and needs on the Salmon-Challis east of MAP 10.
 Resources:
 Lemoore County: Forest Staff, LEMOORE County Sheriff's Office.
 Operational Resource needs will be determined given fire location, fuels, topography, and values. Risk to personnel will be a factor in determining actions.
- MAP 11: North Fork to Carmen WUI**
 Condition: If fire becomes established on the East Side of the River.
 Description: This MAP runs along the Salmon River from the North Fork southward to Carmen Creek.
 Actions:
 1. Fire may threaten the WUI corridor from North Fork to Carmen, Idaho. Consider actions based on current and expected fire behavior to initiate protection measures.
 2. Operations notifies Lemoore County Sheriff to issue evacuation notices if fire conditions warrant closure of Highway 93.
 3. Operations implements structure protection measures based on plans, fire behavior and personal safety.
 4. Lemoore County Sheriff and Salmon City officials and BLM Salmon Field Office are aware of the fire.
 5. LEMOORE County may assist with fire behavior projections regarding when/where impacts might occur.
 6. Coordinate responses within the Lemoore County Fire Protection District.
 7. Forest needs to assess planning area to the Southward.
 Resources:
 Lemoore County: Sheriff's Office, IOT, Safety Officer.
 Operational Resources includes 20 Engines, 5 water tenders, 4 Dozers, 3 HC, 2 Type 2 IA Crews, 3 Tank Force Leaders, 3 Type 1 Helicopters, and 1 Air Attack.
- MAP 12: Salmon WUI**
 Condition: If fire becomes established on the East Side of the River.
 Description: MAP 12 extends from Stormy Peak Road near Lemoore County Fairgrounds along the edge of the water treatment plant near Stormy Creek south to the Spring Creek Road.
 Actions:
 1. Fire may threaten the WUI corridor of Salmon, Idaho. Consider actions based on current and expected fire behavior to initiate protection measures.
 2. Operations notifies Lemoore County Sheriff to issue evacuation notices if fire conditions warrant closure of Highway 93.
 3. Operations implements structure protection measures based on plans, fire behavior and personal safety.
 4. Lemoore County Sheriff and Salmon City officials and BLM Salmon Field Office are aware of the fire.
 5. LEMOORE County may assist with fire behavior projections regarding when/where impacts might occur.
 6. Coordinate responses within the Lemoore County Fire Protection District.
 7. Forest needs to assess planning area to the Southward.
 Resources:
 Lemoore County: Sheriff's Office, IOT, Safety Officer.
 Operational Resources includes 20 Engines, 5 water tenders, 4 Dozers, 3 HC, 2 Type 2 IA Crews, 3 Tank Force Leaders, 3 Type 1 Helicopters, and 1 Air Attack/HCCO. Additional resource needs may be required as complexity escalates.
