## **Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:**

Tonight's interpretation began with the event polygon downloaded at 0300 MDT on 9/2/2023 (3,315.495 acres).

Fog in the drainages observed in the imagery, which may have obscured heat signatures in the northern part of the imagery. All heat mapped as observed. Isolated heat sources within the perimeter. Scattered heat on the southeast side of the heat perimeter in the vicinity of fool creek drainage. Small amount of heat perimeter growth found in the spot of intense heat which is depicted within the unnamed drainage to the south of Fool Creek.

Isolated heat outside perimeter along the Clear Creek and the road to the SW.(4.4 miles away) 44 24.45 N and 115 56.82 W Heat also observed at Horsethief Reservoir State Park and Bull Creek Hot Springs.
