6. Control Operations/Work Assignments:

Task: Continue rehab work where needed per guidelines from REAFs. Create fuel mitigations in and around Green Lakes Campground. Remove fire weakened trees along 680 Rd and Spurs. Construct a shaded fuel break behind Thompson Outfitter Camp for future fire risk mitigation. Patrol from A/O Division break to DP20.

Purpose: To keep fire within primary firing and holding indirect line construction by mixed tactics. Additionally, to mitigate suppression impacts while creating opportunities for success in future need.

End State: The fire is fully secured within current control features. Mop-up is completed to a depth that reduces the risk of escape. Contingency line prep along Green River is complete, providing a strengthened barrier to keep the fire east and south of the road.. Fire line is rehabilitated to agency standards..

Operating in Cold Weather - Avoid the Crud

- Cold and Flu Season is upon us. It's imperative that personnel keep eating well and hydrating. Stay on top of vitamin and electrolyte intake. See Medical Unit for medicines and other needed supplies to remedy and keep colds in check.
- Be cognizant of your sleeping patterns. It is easy to get behind on sleep if you're not sleeping well due to cold weather. Communicate needs such as additional sleeping bags, blankets, clothes etc. etc. and work with Supply to address those needs.
- Pay attention and maintain personal hygiene standards. Wash hands whenever possible and utilize hand sanitizer when available. Keep a clean camp and sleeping area.

Keeping Warm

- Dress in layers, add and remove as necessary. A moisture wicking base layer along with an insulating middle layer and a waterproof outer layer to stay warm and dry if necessary.
- Just like you need to take breaks from work your body needs breaks from the cold. Take warm up breaks if necessary and drink warm liquids/foods if possible.
- Although counter intuitive to working try and limit exerting to the point of sweating. Moisture and cold weather do not mix well and can cause problems. Remove any wet clothing immediately.

Take care of your health, hygiene and wellbeing. Eat and hydrate properly to support your immune system. Don't skip on healthy fats and carbohydrates.

Ensure you are getting enough rest and quality sleep. Don't be afraid to take a shower.


