#### 6. Control Operations/Work Assignments:

**Task:** Continue rehab work where needed per guidelines from REAFs. Create fuel mitigations in and around Green Lakes Campground. Remove fire weakened trees along 680 Rd and Spurs. Construct a shaded fuel break behind Thompson Outfitter Camp for future fire risk mitigation. Patrol from A/O Division break to DP20.

**Purpose:** To keep fire within primary firing and holding indirect line construction by mixed tactics. Additionally, to mitigate suppression impacts while creating opportunities for success in future need.

**End State:** The fire is fully secured within current control features. Mop-up is completed to a depth that reduces the risk of escape. Contingency line prep along Green River is complete, providing a strengthened barrier to keep the fire east and south of the road. Fire line is rehabilitated to agency standards.

## Operational Tempo

Operational tempo is the speed and intensity of our actions relative to the speed and intensity of unfolding events in the operational environment. Within this context, fire leaders plan, prepare, and execute operations proactively, rather than continuously being forced to react to the environment.

Successfully maintaining operational tempo is not solely about speeding up to match or exceed the pace of the environment. It is also about knowing when operations should slow down and why.

We are most vulnerable to accidents and errors when the operational tempo is changing, especially when it changes quickly. Maintaining good situation awareness despite change in operational tempo represents a considerable challenge.

The key to managing operational tempo successfully is monitoring the changing environment and capabilities of the team and then applying good judgment to determine whether to push forward or pull back while making necessary planning and resource adjustments.

While the Operational Tempo seems to have slowed down somewhat overall,

I sense that it might be increasing with the repair work left and the Team timing out in the next few days to have things wrapped up.

With that said, try and review the 8-line process and be familiar with calling in a medical IWI. Run a scenario with your crew as you're driving out to the line. Relate it to your current task assignment and environment. Think about the time it will take to get to definitive care as you progress throughout your day.
