Medical Incident Report

FOR ALL MEDICAL EMERGENCIES: IDENTIFY ON SCENE I.C. BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE "MEDICAL EMERGENCY" TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM DISPATCH.

Use items 1 through 8 to communicate situation to dispatch							
1. CONTACT DISPATCH: Ex: "Dispatch, Div. Alpha. Stand-by for Emergency Traffic"							
2. INCIDENT STATUS: Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure. Ex: "Dispatch, I have a Red priority patient, unconscious, struck by a falling tree. Requesting air ambulance to Forest Road at (Lat./Long.). This will be the Trout Meadow Medical, IC is TFLD Jones. EMT Smith is providing medical care.

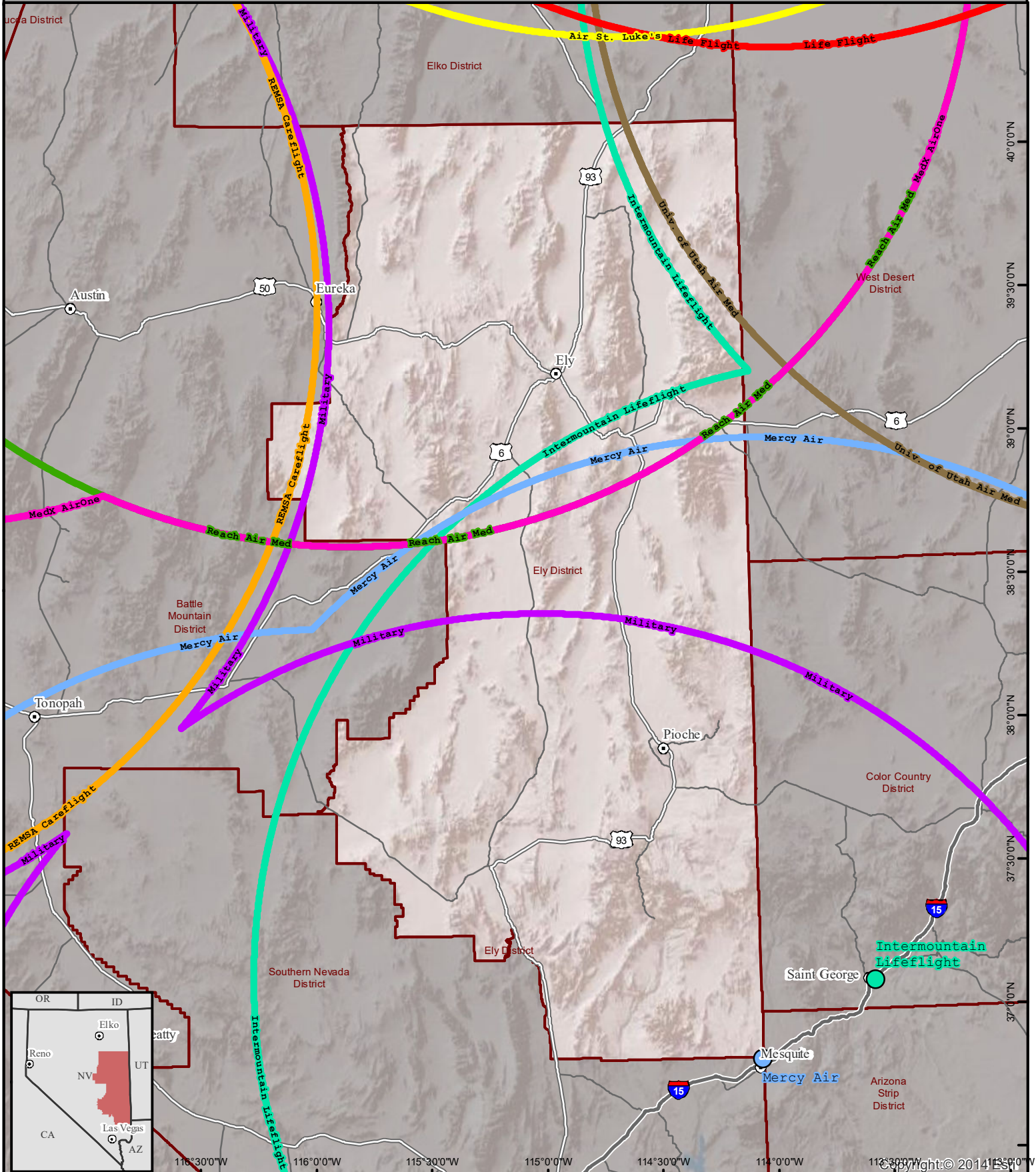

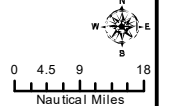

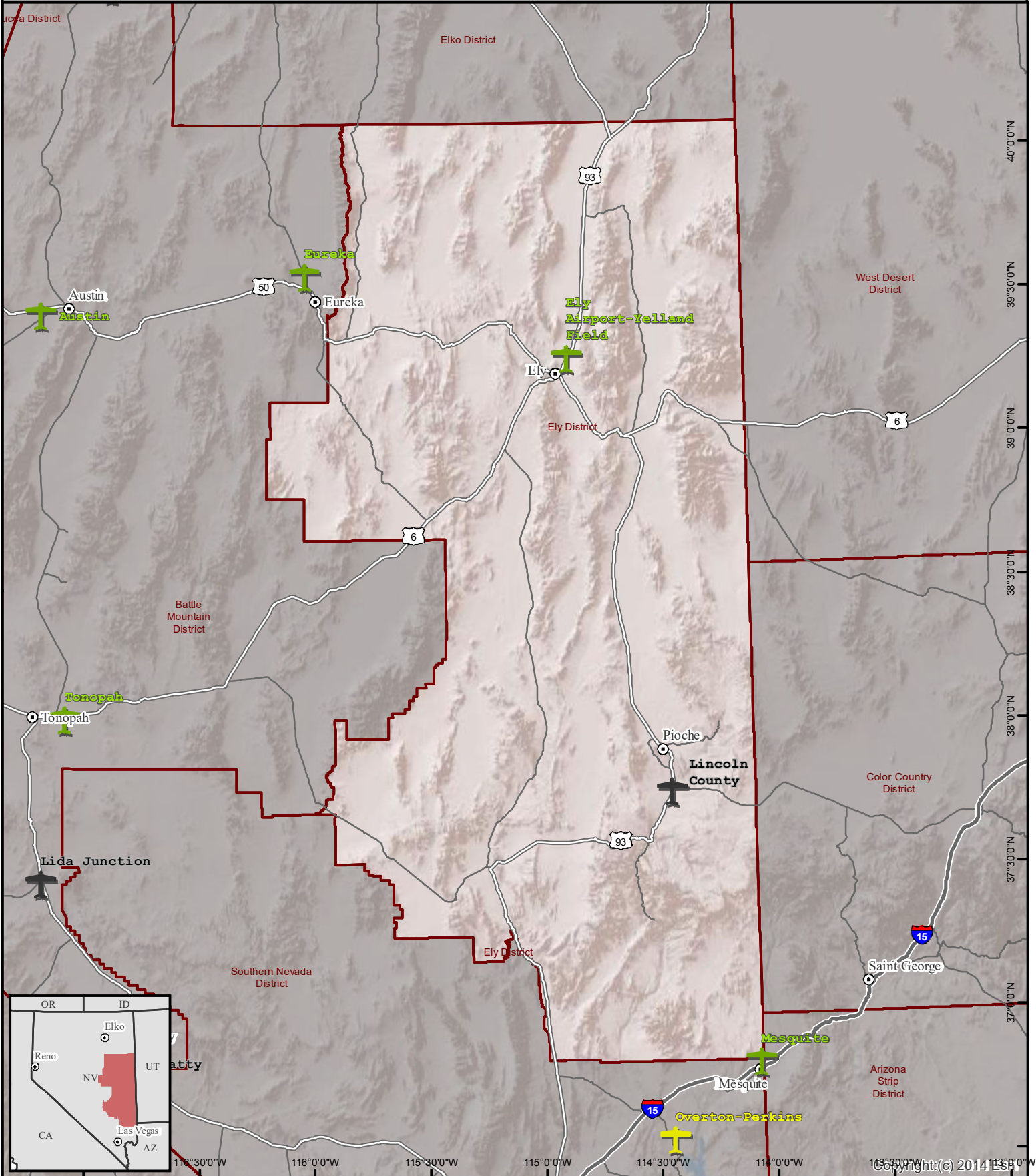

Nevada Airports & Fuel Availability

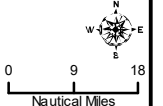

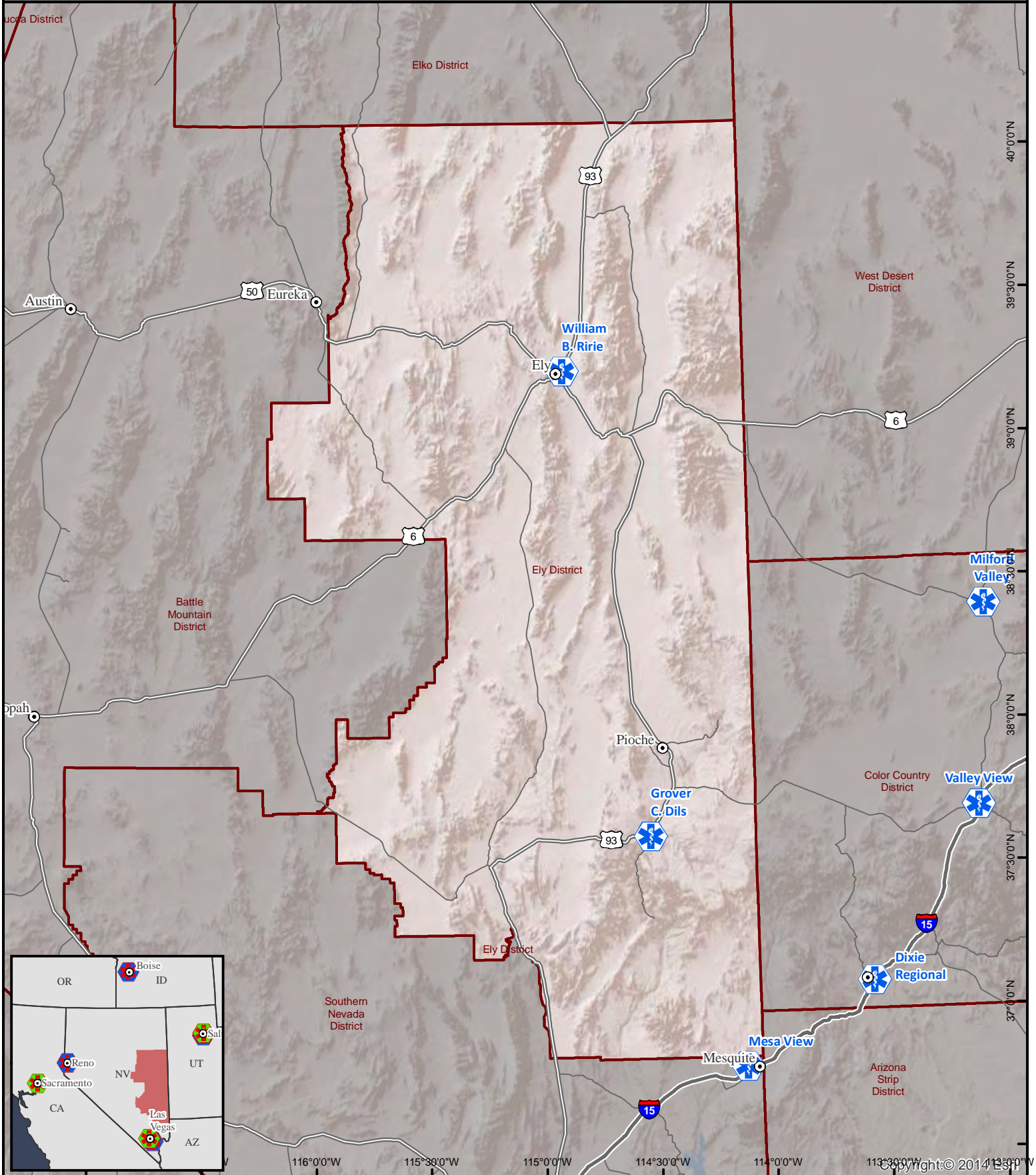
