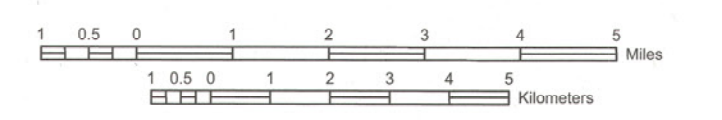

CHECK YOUR MOTOR VEHICLE USE MAP

The Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM) is a companion map to the one you are holding. It identifies the roads, trails, and areas where motor vehicles are allowed. It also shows areas where motor vehicles are prohibited. It is a good idea to check your MVUM before you travel.

Public lands outside the National Forest boundary were compiled from BLM land status maps. Check with the appropriate agency for current land status information. Public lands are subject to changes and leasing. Local inquiry should be made before entering.

Many routes across private lands (white on this map) may not be available for public use. Please respect private property.

NOTE: No motorist vehicles allowed on any trails. Please see Travel Management Map for OHV use areas and policy.

NATIONAL FOREST ROUTE MARKERS

214 Roads maintained for LOW clearance vehicles, such as sedans, trailers, and motorhomes.

53 Roads suitable for HIGH clearance vehicles, such as 4x4s and pickups.

CLOSED TO ALL OTHER USES TO RETURN ROAD OR TRAIL TO ITS ORIGINAL CONDITION
