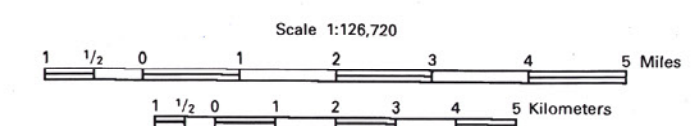


FOREST VISITOR/TRAVEL MAP

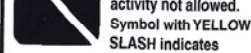
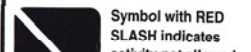
