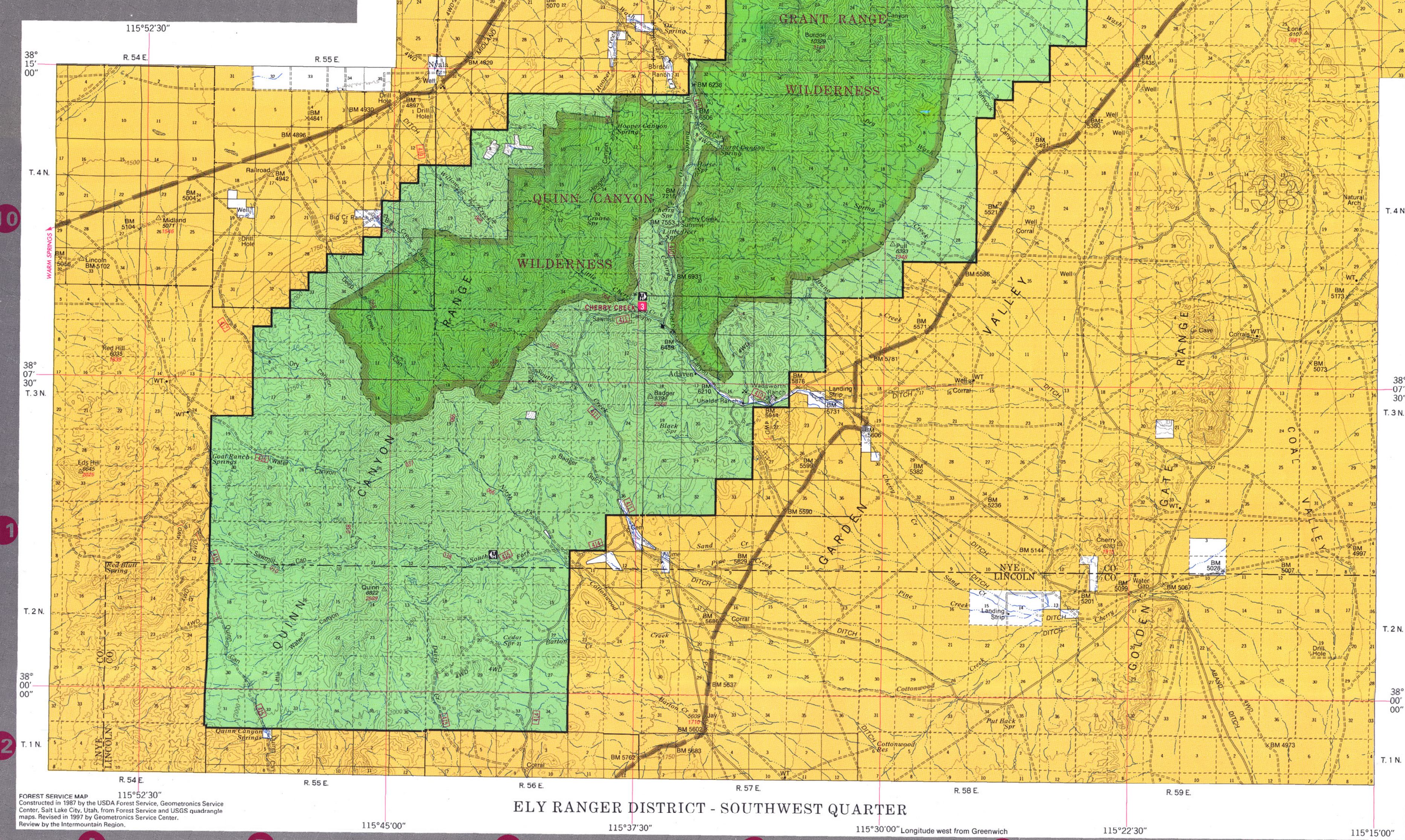
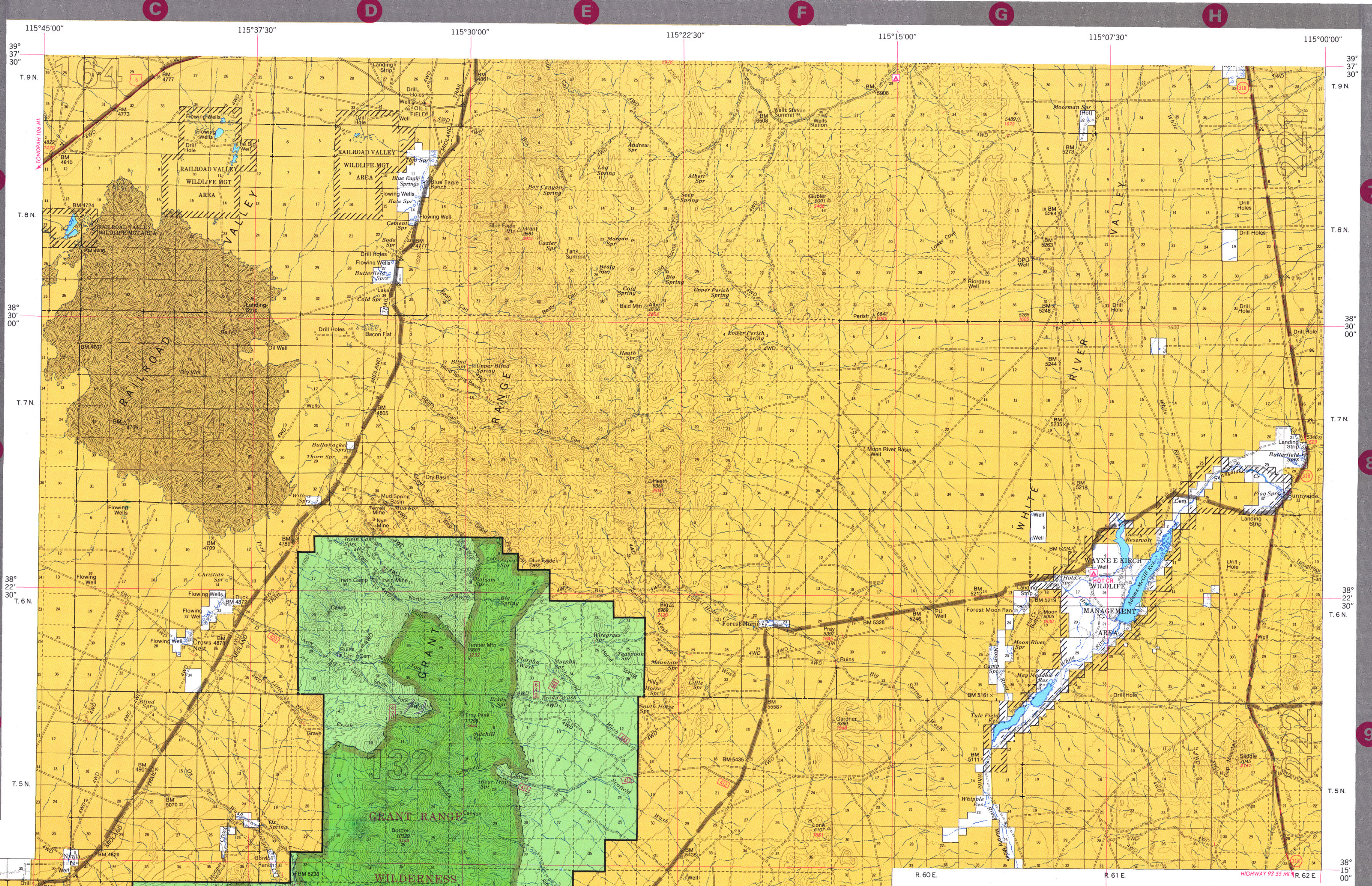

Roads maintained for passenger cars.

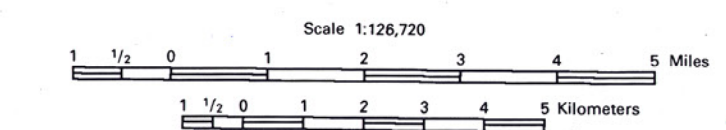
