

SPECIAL ORDER
OCCUPANCY AND USE
UINTA NATIONAL FOREST

04-18-93-08

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a), the following acts are prohibited on the Uinta National Forest until further notice:

1. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire or campfire within the Mt. Timpanogos Wilderness Area and the Silver Lake Basin of the Lone Peak Wilderness Area as shown on the attached map, Exhibit A; (36 CFR 261.52 (a)).
2. Possessing, storing, or transporting any part of a tree or other plant material for the purpose of building, maintaining, attending or using a fire or campfire within the Mt. Timpanogos Wilderness Area and the Silver Lake Basin of the Lone Peak Wilderness Area as shown on the attached map, Exhibit A; (36 CFR 261.58 (t)).

Other regulations which are applicable include cutting or otherwise damaging any timber, tree, or other Forest product within the Mt. Timpanogos Wilderness Area and the Silver Lake Basin of the Lone Peak Wilderness Area as shown on the attached map, Exhibit A; (36 CFR 261.6 (a)).

This closure is within the Pleasant Grove Ranger District of the Uinta National Forest, east of American Fork and Pleasant Grove, and is being implemented to protect limited and scarce timber resources and protect the quality of unique wilderness resources consistent with Leave No Trace principles. Backpack gas stoves, charcoal with a fire pan, or canned fuel stoves are recommended.

Violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 or imprisonment of not more than 6 months, or both. (16 USC 551 and 7 USC 1011 f).
