PINEVIEW OCCUPANCY SPECIAL ORDER

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and 36 CFR 261.50(b), in order to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited on the National Forest System areas described in this order. All lands affected are located on the Ogden Ranger District, Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect from 12:01 a.m. Saturday, May 8, 2004 until further notice:

1. **Overnight Watercraft Use.** Going into or being upon the area, unless posted or marked as open. Boats must be anchored at least 20 feet off the shore to stay overnight. 36 CFR 261.53 (e)
2. **Use of Docks.** No Swimming, diving, or fishing is allowed on or within 50 feet of public docking facilities located on the reservoir. 36CFR 261.53 (e)
3. **Alcoholic beverages.** Possessing a beverage which is defined as an alcoholic beverage by Utah State law at Cemetery Point Beach. This includes the managed beach, water and parking lot as posted. 36 CFR 261.58 (bb)
4. **Glass.** Possessing, using, or storing any type of glass container except in the following areas: Lawn covered areas at Cemetery Point, Middle Inlet, and Anderson Cove Beach or at both Anderson Cove and Jefferson Hunt Campgrounds. 261.58(cc)
5. **Fires.** Building maintaining, attending, or using a fire or campfire except in permanently constructed fire rings within developed recreation sites. 36 CFR 261.52(a).
6. **Camping** except within developed campgrounds. 36 CFR 261.58 (e)
7. **Watercraft Use.** Possessing or operating a motor boat within a developed swim area. 36 CFR 261.58 (n)


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
2. Any Federal, state, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION

All lands administered by the Forest Service in the vicinity of Pineview Reservoir and specifically includes the entire shoreline, beaches, developed recreation sites, water surface area and other National Forest lands adjacent to Pineview Reservoir, as shown on the map. All of National Forest Lands in Sections 34 and 36, T7N, R1E; Sections 1, 2, 3, 10, 12, 13, 14, 15, and 16, T6N, R1E; Sections 6, 7, and 18, 19, T6N, R2E

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment of not more than 6 months, or both. 16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571.

This order supersedes previous Order No. 04-19-038 and 04-19-029 dated 4-2-1997, for the above described area and prohibitions.
