FERGUSON CANYON FIRE/CAMPING  
SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR  
WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FOREST  
Salt Lake Ranger District

The following act is established to provide for public safety and to prevent significant water, soil, and vegetation resource damage.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the areas described on the attached map and described in this order within the Wasatch-Cache National Forest until further notice.


1. Building, maintaining, attending or using a campfire within Ferguson Canyon drainage and adjacent areas as described on the attached map. [36 CFR 261.52 (a)].
2. Camping within the Ferguson Canyon drainage and adjacent areas as described on the attached map. [36 CFR 261.58 (e)]
3. Going into or being in Ferguson Canyon from 10:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M. within the area described on the attached map. [36 CFR 261.53 (e)]

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit.
2. Authorized Federal, state, or local officers, or members of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of official duty, when authorized by the District Ranger.

Area Described

Lower Ferguson Canyon drainage and adjacent National Forest lands as described on the attached map.
